What's New On the Electronic Campus

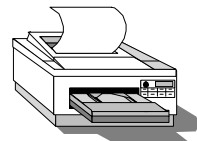


WPS Plus and 20/20 spreadsheet will no longer be offered on the VAX starting May 18, 1998. Also, as of April 1, 1998, **user@mail.nwmissouri.edu** should be used for VAX/VMS e-mail. In addition, **info.nwmissouri.edu** will be substituted for acad.nwmissouri.edu. However, **info.** will not be active until sometime this summer. Short courses on converting WPS to MS Word will be offered in April and May. Between May and June, e-mail will be switched from the VAX to an MS Exchange server, with faculty utilizing Microsoft Outlook and students utilizing a web browser to access their mail messages. Academic Computing will hold computer short courses dealing with various software, including Microsoft Outlook this summer. The hour to two hour "hands-on" courses are held in Thompson-Ringgold's Computer Lab, Room 114C.
