The Office of Scholarships and Financial Assistance will evaluate eligibility for the Heroes Act after this form and the DD-214 are received. Veterans must maintain a 2.50 cumulative GPA in order to maintain eligibility for additional semesters. Each semester, the amount of the Heroes Act award will be calculated using several factors: the number of credit hours in which the veteran in enrolled, the amount of other federal and state grants and tuition assistance the veteran is receiving, and the educational cost of attendance defined by the requirements of the federal financial aid programs. The value of the Heroes Act will be placed on the student's financial aid award and the student account will reflect an amount which will reduce the amount of tuition charges to \$50 per credit hour for undergraduate students. Graduate students tuition will be reduced to no more than 30% of tuition and required fees.
