The Booth College of Business and Professional Studies at Northwest Missouri State University is again offering a scholarship for incoming freshmen.

Each scholarship is a non-renewable award of approximately \$1,400 (subject to availability of funds) available to two students who plan to enroll at Northwest Missouri State University as a full-time, first semester freshman student in the fall of 2010.

Requirements: The student applying for the scholarship must major in one of the following areas in the Booth College of Business and Professional Studies:

- Accounting
- Economics
- Finance
- Business Education
- International Business
- Office Information Systems
- Management Information Systems
- Broadcasting
- Journalism
- Agriculture
- Marketing
- Management
- Computer Science

Selection of the scholarship winners by the committee will be based upon the following:

1. Information provided on the [application form](#).
2. One letter of recommendation from a high school teacher, counselor, or administrator.
3. A one or two page essay about
 - why the individual wants to pursue a career in the selected field and
 - why the individual wants to pursue an education in that field at Northwest

The application packet should include the completed application form, the essay, and a transcript. The letter of recommendation should be under separate cover. Applications should be postmarked no later than December 10, 2009. Scholarship recipients will be notified in January 2010.
