

C. L. Butler Scholarship

The C.L. Butler Scholarship has been endowed in the Northwest Foundation, Inc., for entering freshmen at Northwest Missouri State University in Maryville, MO. For the 2012-2013 academic year, all applicants pursuing secondary education will be considered, with preference given to those pursuing mathematics education, and special preference to those planning a mathematics major and English (or other area of the humanities) minor or second major. Recipients of the Butler Scholarship will show outstanding potential in their area of study as evidenced by their excellent ACT scores and will demonstrate a need for financial assistance. The award will be in the amount of \$1,500 for the academic year. Based on the recommendations of the Selection Committee, the scholarship may be renewed throughout the recipient's education at Northwest Missouri State University for a maximum of 4 years.

Eligibility requirements for 2012-2013 awards will be based upon the following criteria:

1. Applicants must be high school graduating seniors in the spring of 2012.
2. Applicants must enter a secondary education program. Preference will be given to those who will pursue mathematics education, and special preference will be given to those planning a mathematics major and English (or other area of the humanities) minor or second major.
3. Applicants must show outstanding potential in their area of study as evidenced by their excellent ACT scores and must submit a copy of ACT scores with application.
4. Applicants must submit an essay to the scholarship committee and share a personal statement of financial need.
5. All applicants will be notified of the committee's decision.
6. Eligible recipients must be entering freshmen for the 2012-2013 academic year at Northwest Missouri State University in Maryville, MO.
7. Eligible recipients must be enrolled as full-time students.
8. The scholarships will be distributed in two equal amounts for the fall and spring trimesters.
9. The scholarships may be renewed upon the recommendation of the Selection Committee. Renewals shall be based on, but not limited to, maintaining a 3.0 cumulative GPA; submitting a copy of his/her transcript for the current academic year; submitting a written statement from his/her advisor verifying his/her continued pursuit of both a teaching degree program and the major/minor designated and approved in his/her original scholarship application; and the recommendation of the Selection Committee.
10. **Completed applications must be received by the Office of Scholarships and Financial Assistance by March 1, 2012.**
