## UNDERGRADUATE COSTS

FALL 2009 - SUMMER 2010

### TUITION/INCIDENTAL FEE

- ▶ \$157.39 per credit hour, in-state resident
- ▶ \$314.78 per credit hour, out-of-state resident

### TUITION/DESIGNATED FEES

- ▶ \$59 per credit hour

### TEXTBOOK USAGE FEE

- ▶ \$6 per credit hour  
Primary textbooks are provided for undergraduate coursework. Purchase of supplemental materials may be required. On average, students may spend \$150 per year on supplemental materials.

### TECHNOLOGY FEE

- ▶ \$12 per credit hour  
This fee provides for the maintenance and upgrades of the electronic classrooms, instructional technology, internet in residence halls and computer labs. All full-time students are provided a laptop computer.
