UNDERGRADUATE COSTS

FALL 2011 - SUMMER 2012

TUITION/INCIDENTAL FEE

- ▶ \$167.55 per credit hour, in-state resident
- ▶ \$362.98 per credit hour, out-of-state resident

TUITION/DESIGNATED FEES

- ▶ \$60.25 per credit hour

TEXTBOOK USAGE FEE

- ▶ \$6 per credit hour
Primary textbooks are provided for undergraduate coursework. Purchase of supplemental materials may be required. On average, students may spend \$150 per year on supplemental materials.

TECHNOLOGY FEE

- ▶ \$14 per credit hour
This fee provides for the maintenance and upgrades of the electronic classrooms, instructional technology, internet in residence halls and computer labs. All full-time students are provided a laptop computer.
