The faculty of the Department of Art have reviewed the course descriptions and syllabi completed in classes from the Advertising – Motion Graphic Design Department of Byuksung College. The following list comprises those courses that appear to be compatible with our own offerings in the Department of Art for the Interactive Digital Media (IDM) major with a concentration in Visual Imaging (VI). As is our policy for any incoming off-campus transfer student, we will require a portfolio review to make a final determination of which courses (in the following list) we would accept as transfer credit toward a specific Northwest Department of Art course within our degree programs.

Contingent upon the outcome of a portfolio review of the student seeking to transfer courses from Byuksung College to the Northwest Department of Art, the following courses from Byuksung would be considered for transfer credit for the following courses at Northwest when applied to the IDM-VI program.
