* Recommended elective

- Students who have had two or three years of Spanish in high school should take 142 in the Fall instead of 141.
- Students who have had three or more years of Spanish in high school should be ready for 242 in the Fall instead of 141.
- 141 and 142 do not count towards the major or minor. 141 or 142 meet the multicultural Institutional Requirement: courses in other departments meet this need also. Test outs are available for these two courses.
- 21 of the 24 hours from the electives starting at the 200 level are required for the major, 12 hours for the minor.
- Study Abroad experience is strongly recommended for majors and minors.
- Pre-req for Contemporary Mexico, can be either 243, or students must have taken at least 3 courses of Spanish. 14-348 is an elective course that can be taken on the second year Summer, or in latter Summer offerings.
- Literature courses may also be taken concurrently with 342 and 343.
- 14-446 (2-3 hrs practicum) should be taken as study abroad if possible. Some substitutions are possible.
- 14-485 (1 hr. Senior Seminar) At least one 400-level course should be taken before 485.
- In some cases, a 400 level literature course may be substituted for a lower course or for 446 or 485.
- 14-449 (Independent Study) is intended for independent research above and beyond normal course offerings. It may, in some cases, be used to supplement 446. It is not a course substitute.
- Other Electives in Spanish (as in the 2008-2010 catalog) are:

14-348 Spanish History and Culture (3)	14-444 Spanish American Literature (3)
14-443 Spain in the 19 th and 20 th Centuries (3)	14-445 Medieval and Golden Age Literature of Spain (3)

Students must earn a minimum total of 124 hours to complete their degree
