

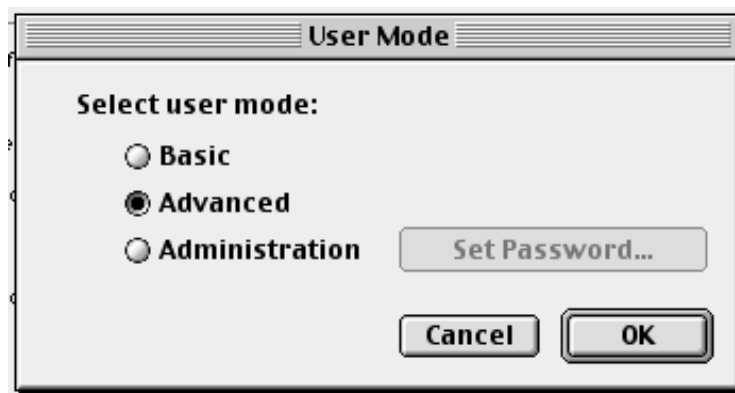
Installing Your Personal Computer to the Northwest Network Using Mac OS 8.x-9.x

Note: Information Systems will configure your personal PC to work properly on the Northwest network for a \$25.00 charge, which will be automatically billed to your University account. If you are interested in having Information Systems configure your personal PC, contact the Help Desk at 660-562-1634.

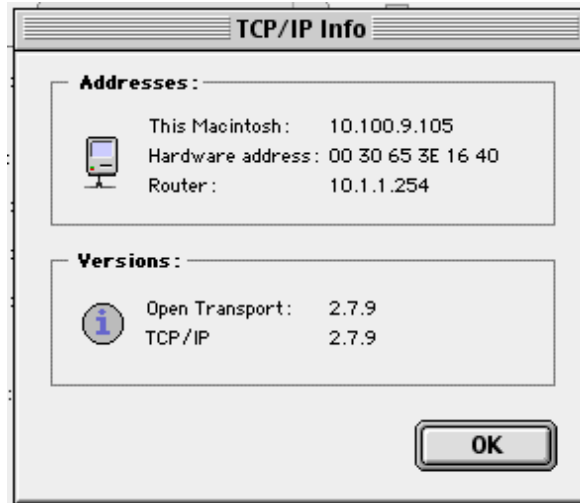
By joining the Northwest domain you will have seamless access to networked printers and files shares. However, if you choose not wish to join the domain and remain a part of another Workgroup, you will NOT have easy access to campus network services. All computers on the Northwest network are required to have current anti-virus software installed and activated on the computer.

Locating the hardware/MAC Address:

1. Click on the **Apple Menu**.
2. Select **Control Panels**.
3. Click on **TCP/IP**.
4. Click on the **Edit** menu.
5. Click on **User Mode**.
6. Change **Select user mode:** from **Basic** to **Advanced**.
7. Click **OK**.



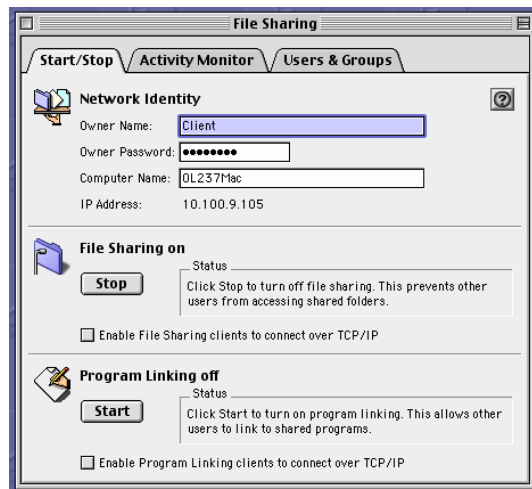
8. Click on the **Info** button.
 - The hardware/MAC address is the **Hardware address:** under the **Addresses:** section (ex. 00:00:00:00:00:00).
9. Click **OK**.



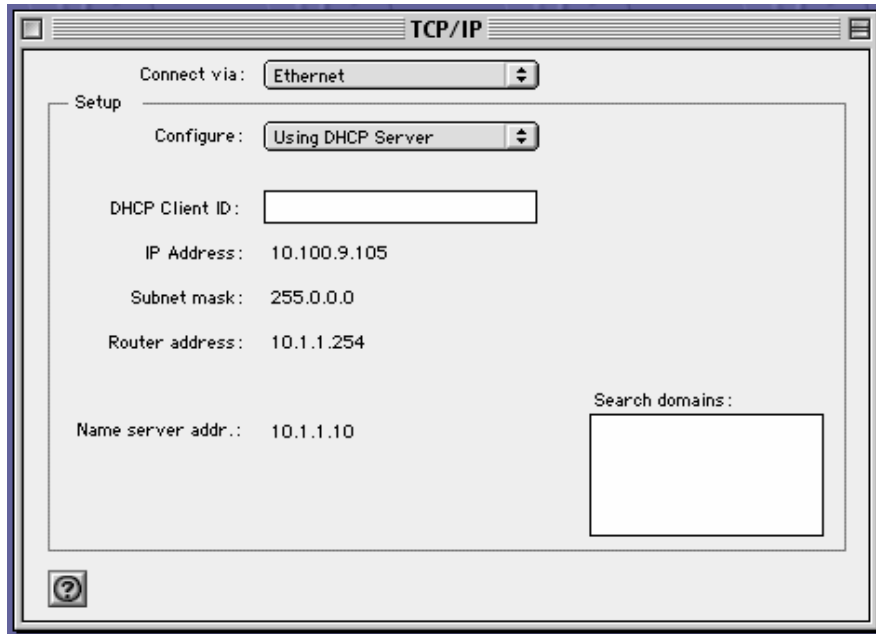
Joining Your Computer to the Northwest Network:

1. Click on the **Apple Menu**.
2. Select **Control Panels**.
3. Click on **File Sharing**.
4. Under **Start/Stop** tab in the **Network Identity** section.
5. Enter your name for **Owner Name:**
6. Enter a password for **Owner Password:**
7. Change the **Computer Name:**
 - Remember your computer name **MUST** be the two or three-letter residence hall room abbreviation followed by your room number, and then either A, B, C, D etc., depending upon the number of personal computers in the residence hall. There should be **NO** spaces in the name. Example(s): DO349A and HUC114A.

Note: For a list of residence hall abbreviations, see the Building Code Table in Northwest Electronic Campus Network Policies. Also, see the Building Code Table listed on the next page of this document.



8. Close **File Sharing** window.
9. Click on the **Apple Menu**.
10. Select **Control Panels**.
11. Click on **TCP/IP**.
12. Change **Connect via:** to **Ethernet built-in** or **Ethernet**.
13. Change **Configure:** to **Using DHCP Server**.
14. Close **TCP/IP** window.
15. If asked, click the **Save** button on the **Save changes to current configuration?**



Note: Your computer should now be set up to work correctly on the campus network.
