Turning On the Computer (Booting)

Note: If the power indicator on the monitor is orange and the power indicator on the computer is green the machine is in the Power Save mode. Press the spacebar to "wake-up" the machine.

1. Push the power button on the monitor. The power indicator light should come on.
2. Push the power button on the computer. The power indicator light should come on along with the hard disk drive light.
3. Type the network username **bearcat** when prompted, and then press **[Enter]**.

Note: The network username and password are required for printing and server file storage for PC based applications. (Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Internet Explorer, etc.) The bearcat username does not have a password and will not allow printing or server file storage from PC based applications. To obtain a personal username for printing from PC based applications, stop by the Data Processing in the Administration. For password concerns, stop by the Academic Computing office in Owens Library.

Starting Up the Computer From Power Save Mode

Note: If the power indicator on the monitor is orange and the power indicator on the computer is green, the machine is in power save mode.

1. To start the machine up from Power Save mode press the **[Spacebar]**.
