

Deleting Temporary Internet Files

Summary

This document shows you how to delete your PC's Temporary Internet Files. By deleting Temporary Internet Files you could help speed up your PC.

How to Delete Temporary Internet Files

1. Click on Internet Explorer

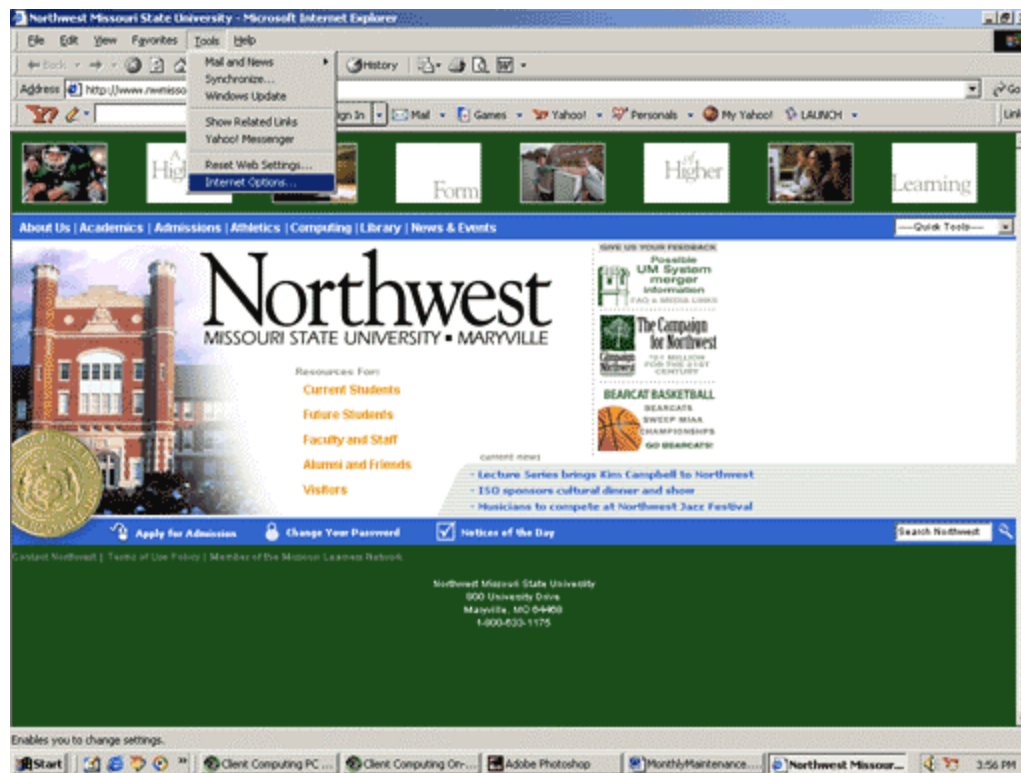


Figure 1. Internet Explorer Tools menu. Internet Options is highlighted.

2. Click Tools on the top menu bar (*See Figure 1*)
3. Click Internet Options (*See Figure 1*)
 - The Internet Options window will appear. It should automatically open on the General tab. If not, click on the General tab.

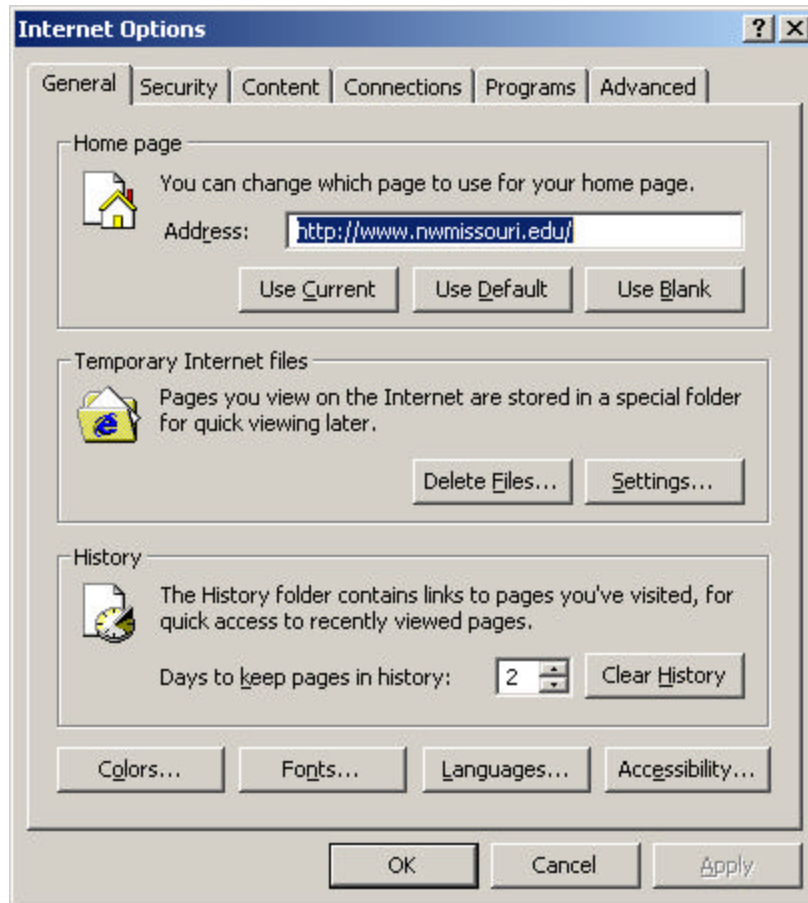


Figure 2. Internet Options menu. Shows the Delete Files button for Temporary Internet Files on the General Tab. Note: The Delete Cookies button would be located on the General Tab as well if it is available.

4. Click on the Delete Files button (*See Figure 2*)
5. Click OK to delete the files
6. Click on the Delete Cookies button (if available)
7. Click OK to delete the cookies
 - You have now deleted your PC's Temporary Internet Files.
