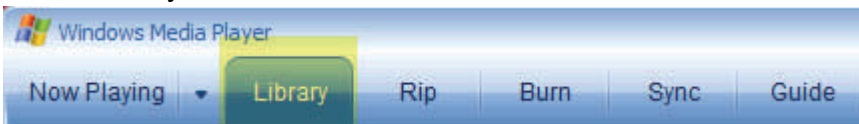





## Downloading from NetLibrary to an MP3 Player

- Go to netlibrary.com (if you're a first-time user, select "Create a Free Account" in topgreen navigation bar)
- Select "Log In" in top green navigation bar (login with username/password)
- Search for eAudiobook (Full-Text, Author, Title, Keyword, Subject)
- Select "Download this eAudiobook"
- Select "Check Out & Download CD Quality" (for listening via MP3 player) or "Radio Quality" (for listening via computer)
- Click Save button
- Save to My Documents—My Music—Create a new folder called NetLibrary—Click Save
- Select Start—All Programs—Accessories—Entertainment—Windows Media Player
- Click "Library" tab

- Select "By Monitored Folders" (this should only need to be done once per computer)
    - Select "Add..." button
    - Select My Documents—My Music—NetLibrary (Click OK button)
    - Click OK button
  - The downloaded eAudiobooks should appear in your library's playlist
  - Right click on a title you'd like to download to MP3 Player
  - Select Add to—Sync List
  - Select "Sync" tab
  - Select "Start Sync"
    - If you receive "Error: Unable to obtain license", you may need to double-click item, select "Yes" to obtain the license, click Log In, and login with your Netlibrary login/password).
