Section Revocation of Parking

I. Purpose

The goal of the University Traffic Advisory Committee is to provide high quality parking and traffic services within an ever-changing environment.

II. Policy

1. The Director of Campus Safety shall suspend or revoke a driver's parking privileges for any of the following reasons:
 - a. When violations exceed 12 during the permit year (Sept. 1-Aug. 31).
 - b. Where fraudulent permits are obtained.
 - c. Leaving the scene of an accident.
 - d. Careless and imprudent driving.
 - e. Driving while intoxicated.
2. All revocations made by the Director of Campus Safety shall be effective for the remainder of the permit year in which the revocation order is issued, or as otherwise specified.
3. Student Affairs may revoke parking privileges through the Student-Faculty Discipline Committee.
4. Payment or appeal of any traffic citation does not exempt one from the standard revocation procedure.
