**Chapter** Campus Safety

**Section** Traffic Policies, Operating  
of Vehicles

### I. Purpose

The goal of the University Traffic Advisory Committee is to provide high quality parking and traffic services within an ever-changing campus environment.

### II. Policy

1. Observe all campus traffic and parking signs. *Posted signs shall supersede this written policy.*
2. The maximum speed limit on campus is 20 M.P.H. and 10 M.P.H. in parking lots. Violators are subject to University citation.
3. State and city motor vehicle traffic laws are included in the University's motor vehicle regulations governing the use of vehicles on the University campus.
4. No one is permitted to drive around or over any barricade erected to control traffic or parking, or to alter, deface, remove, or destroy any traffic or parking control device.
5. A vehicle operator shall comply with instructions given by a Campus Safety Officer (voice, gesture, or whistle).
6. Vehicles shall not be parked against the flow of traffic.
