## Purpose

To outline courses counting toward multiple requirements.

## Policy

Students may use Northwest or transferred coursework to fulfill requirements for two (or more) comprehensive majors, regular majors, and minors, unless specifically prohibited in catalog.

Each comprehensive major, regular major, and minor shall consist of at least 12 hours of unique coursework not applied to any other comprehensive majors, regular majors, or minors.

Any application of courses counting toward multiple requirements shall not affect the total hours needed for graduation and/or the programs to which the course is applied.
