## <u>Purpose</u>

Every student enrolled at Northwest is required to have an identification card (Bearcat Card), to carry it at all times, and to present it when requested by University personnel.

## Policy and Procedure

All graduate and undergraduate students should report to the ID Office, in the J.W. Jones Union, as soon as they enroll, present their enrollment forms, and receive an ID card. The card is valid as long as the student is enrolled at Northwest.

The Bearcat Card serves as a meal card for students. In addition, the card is used:

- In the library
- At sporting events
- For the copy machines and vending machines
- Can be used as an ATM and debit card worldwide if the user has a US Bank account

Note: There is a replacement fee if the card is lost or stolen.
