

DYSLEXIA

Missouri educators will be asked to screen all students Grades K-3 for characteristics of Dyslexia at the beginning of the 2018-19 school year.

Dyslexia: Screening & Planning for Academic Growth

March 15 The focus of this day is to develop an understanding for both the screening measures of Dyslexia and the development of a plan of action to address the struggling reader. Time will be spent addressing how to identify, plan and implement a course of action starting from what resources are currently available in the district.

This session will prepare schools to put into place the components needed to address legislation on dyslexia for the 2018-19 school year.

Reaching & Teaching Students with Dyslexia Level I

March 2 or March 28 In this session, participants will take a closer look into understanding, reaching, and teaching, students with reading difficulties that might be signs of dyslexia. The challenges of dyslexia may seem daunting. The good news is, early identification of dyslexia helps a student receive the assistance and resources they need to be successful.

Most of the information in this training will be a repeat of information provided in the dyslexia training by Northwest RPDC in January 2017. Current DESE updates on Dyslexia will be included in this session.

Reaching & Teaching Students with Dyslexia Level II

March 19, March 20 or April 6 This session will provide a closer look into understanding, reaching and teaching students with reading difficulties that might be signs of dyslexia. Most of the instructional time in this training will be hands-on strategy development of effective instruction for students who show common characteristics of dyslexia. If you are wanting strategy instruction to put into place immediately, this session is for you.

Participants who attend this training must already have attended a Level I training for students with dyslexia during this school year or with Northwest RPDC in January 2017.
