

School Wide Positive Behavior Support (SW-PBS)

Target Audience: PK-12 Teachers, All Content Areas, Administrators

Teacher Pre/Post Outcomes: SW-PBS is a process for creating safer and more effective schools by structuring the learning environment to support the academic and social success of all students.

- Awareness Level: 0.5 years
- Skill Level: Year 1
- Implementation Level: Year 2 and beyond - The process supports the adoption and long-term implementation of efficient and effective discipline throughout the school environment.

Student Pre/ Post Outcomes: PBS methods are research-based and proven to significantly reduce the occurrence of problem behaviors in schools.

- Provides for Increased Likelihood of a Safe School Climate
- Encourages Parental Involvement
- Addresses Equitable Achievement across Ethnic and socio-economic status (SES) Groups
- Supports Improved Academic Achievement

- School Safety Survey
- Team Implementation Checklist (quarterly)
- School Data Profile
- Team Meeting Minutes (quarterly)
- Total Office Discipline Referrals (quarterly)
- Schoolwide Evaluation Tool (SET)

Content/Modules:

1. Administrator support, participation and leadership
2. Common purpose and approach to discipline
3. Clear set of positive expectations and behaviors
4. Procedures for teaching expected behavior
5. Continuum of procedures for encouraging expected behaviors
6. Continuum of procedures for discouraging inappropriate behaviors
7. Procedures for ongoing monitoring
