






# Agriculture Learning Center NORTHWEST MISSOURI STATE UNIVERSITY AGRICULTURAL LEARNING CENTER

The Agriculture Learning Center (ALC) will hold it's ribbon cutting ceremony on Friday July 30th at 9:00 am. This 29,000 square foot building houses two classrooms, agriscience agronomy, animal health and meat fabrication labs, a certified commercial processing kitchen, board room, study space, expocenter with concessions area and an outdoor plaza and classroom.

Students, faculty, staff and community members will have opportunities to use the ALC for meetings, activities, and a multitude of agriculture-related events such as producer meetings, industry-related activities, school field trips, lunch-and-learn events, community events, and educational endeavors for youth in agriculture, FFA and 4-H. ### From LAT

All Employee Meeting scheduled for August 13th, in person.

Employee Engagement Survey is scheduled for September.

Shift differential (approved in July by BOR) will go into effect in August.

HR in coordination with BCBS is looking into incentive options for employee vaccinations.

### **Board of Regents Report**

FY22 Budget was approved

As part of the FY22 budget, a 2% COLA increase and additional funding for retirement and healthcare were approved.

Projected fall enrollment of 7,900 students expected (2100 of this total is online).

### **Benefits and Wellness**

B&W is proposing a survey by Lockton Company, the university's benefits consultant.

### **New Items**

Custodial vacancies with the department were discussed. HR is looking into where we fall within CUPA (College and University Professional Association) formulas for base pay. Discussion to continue.

The question of whether a remote work policy had been approved was asked. Krista shared that a policy had been approved in the Fall of 2020. This policy would be separate from any closure due to a University wide event and deal specifically with an individual's ability to perform their work remotely.

### **Committees**

Engagement and Recognition distributed popsicles campus wide. They are working on a Kudos Board to capture praise and compliments on a monthly basis. The committee is looking into helping with the Staff Commitment to Excellence Awards.

Outreach Committee is planning a Bake Sale October 19<sup>th</sup> at the Student Union. All proceeds of this and other fundraisers goes towards the Staff Council Scholarship Fund. A sign up sheet will be out closer to the date for those that may wish to donate sale items.

Policy Committee is working on ratios to make sure groups across campus are adequately represented.



# **COVID-19 UPDATE**

Northwest continues to align its COVID-19 response with the CDC guidelines. As of July 27, Northwest <u>recommends</u> that all individuals wear face coverings in public, indoor settings to maximize protection from the Delta variant. Face coverings are <u>required</u> for all individuals who enter the Wellness Center, Horace Mann Lab School and use public transportation, including Safe Rides. All individuals who are not fully vaccinated are <u>required</u> to wear face coverings on the Northwest campus. For fully vaccinated individuals, face coverings are optional.
