### Quick Hitters

- **Softball:** After earning a berth in the regional tournament for the first time since 1984, three Bearcats earned all-region honors. Senior **Katy John** was a NFCA All-North Central Region First Team pick while freshman **Cola Krueger** and junior **Lindsay Stephenson** were named to the second team.
- **Tennis:** The Bearcats ended their season last Wednesday with losses at the NCAA Division II National Championships to Drury (Mo.). Senior **Gena Lindsay** was honored with the North Central Region ITA/Arthur Ashe Leadership and Sportsmanship Award and was named to the ITA Senior Player of the Year in the region. Head coach **Mark Rosewell** earned the title North Central Region Wilson/ITA Coach of the Year.

### Baseball

**NOTES:** Northwest, who ended its season taking three of four from No. 7 Central Missouri State (May 5-7), placed an athlete on the ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District VII College Division First Team, announced late last week. Senior outfielder **Tristan Stewart**, who earned a Second Team nod last season, sports a 3.92 GPA in psychology. Stewart tied for first on the team with 17 doubles and was second in stolen bases (16-of-20). The Crystal Lake, Ill., native batted .294 with 32 runs driven in and 41 runs scored.

**NOTES:** Ending their season with a school-best 40-15 overall record, Northwest softball participated in its third ever NCAA Tournament and first since 1984. At the North Central Region Championships hosted by Emporia State (May 11-15), Northwest defeated No. 23 Washburn 11-5 after dropping into the losers bracket with a 8-0 loss in five innings to Concordia St. Paul. However, the season came to a close with a 3-1 setback against No. 8 Nebraska-Omaha last Saturday. MIAA Co-Coach of the Year **Susan Anderson** finished her fourth season and sent three Bearcats on the NFCA All-North Central Region Team: senior **Katy John** (1st Team), freshman **Cola Krueger** (2nd Team) and junior **Lindsay Stephenson** (2nd Team). Northwest will lose **John** and **Ashley Pride** to graduation and **Megan Stalder** for personal reasons.

### Men's & Women's Outdoor Track and Field

**Next Meet:** NCAA Division II Championships, Emporia, Kan., May 25-27

**NOTES:** Eight athletes and one relay team from the Bearcat track and field teams are awaiting decisions from NCAA offices on who will advance to the Division II Outdoor Championships at Emporia, Kan., on May 25-27. Participants for the national meet must obtain an automatic qualifying mark in their event, or be invited based on provisional qualifying marks. At the MSSU Last Chance Meet on May 10, senior Travis MacKenzie placed second in the hammer throw with 176' 2 1/2". MacKenzie earlier qualified for the national meet with a school record 184' 6" throw at the Nebraska Invitational on April 15. At the Emporia Twilight Qualifier on May 13, senior Alisha Samuel finished sixth in the 100-meter dash, unable to improve her provisional qualifying mark of 12.09 set at the MIAA Championships set on May 6-7. The women's 400-meter relay team also finished fifth in Emporia, Kan., over the weekend, clocking 48.03. The relay team also provisionally qualified at the MIAA meet, running 46.73.

**NOTES:** The Northwest tennis teams finished their seasons with an appearance at the National Championships in Kansas City, Mo., last weekend. The men were downed 5-0 by No. 1 Drury (Mo.) last Wednesday and the women dropped a 5-2 defeat to No. 24 Drury. The No. 3 doubles team of freshman **Lina Gomez** and Jordan Lipira were victorious as well as freshman Emily Lindsay at No. 6 singles - Lindsay finished with a perfect 18-0 record. On the men's side, the No. 1 and No. 3 doubles teams notched six points in the loss and the No. 2 squad put up four but all three teams fell.

Last week, the MIAA Commissioner's Academic Honor Roll was announced and five men and three women from Northwest were recognized. For the men, **Pablo Acebedo, Lucas Ariboni, Clint Keith, Zach Keith** and **Jon Eric Meyer** and **Carolina Amaral, Amanda Hardie** and **Gena Lindsay** on the women's side.
