Volleyball (7-5 / 0-0 MIAA)

- Sara Falcone led Northwest with 39 kills, 13 blocks and a .414 attack percentage in four matches at last weeken's UW-Parkside Tournament
- Ashley Mitchell had 33 kills and 10 blocks at the tournament. Laira Akin had all but 13 of Northwest's 147 assists.
- Alex Hanna leads the Bearcats with 109 kills this season. Falcone follows with 108.

- Seven different Bearcats have scored a goal this season.
- Heidi Sobota scored two goals in last weeks' games and had one assist.
- Kelsey Sanders leads the team with three assists.
