Track and Field

- Northwest will not compete this weekend and will return to Central Missouri for the UCM Classic on Feb. 19
- Angela Adams won the 5,000-meters at the Husker Invite on Friday with a time of 17:15.07
- Adams' time is the fourth-best time in the nation this season
- Tyler Shaw ran an 8.08 in the 60-meter hurdles, cutting his provisional qualifying time down
- Ben McKim PQ'd in the weight throw Saturday with a career-best throw of 58-9.25

Men's Basketball (11-11, 6-9 MIAA)

- Elijah Allen averaged 19 points per game last week for the Bearcats
- The loss to PSU snaps a bid by Northwest to win three games in a row
- Northwest lost 80-84 in Jan. at Missouri Western in the two's first meeting
- Allen had 25 points and 11 assists in the loss
- Girod Adams had 15 points and six assists against the Griffons earlier this year

Women's Basketball (11-11, 7-8 MIAA)

- Abby Henry set a career-high for points in both games last week
- Gentry Dietz had 18 points and 11 rebounds on Saturday, giving her three double-doubles in the last four games
- Henry had a career-high eight assists Saturday at PSU
- The double-overtime game on Saturday against Pitt., is Northwest's first OT game since Feb. of last season
- The Bearcats were defeated in Jan. the first time they met Missouri Western this season

Softball

- Head Coach Ryan Anderson begins his fourth season with Northwest
- Northwest will play its first 24 games on the road this season
- The Bearcats will host their first home game on March 16 against Wayne State
- Northwest is competing at the Northeastern (Okla.) State Tournament this weekend
- The Bearcats went 13-38 last season

Baseball

- Head Coach Darin Loe begins his 11th season at the helm for the Bearcats
- Northwest finished last season with a 22-27 record
- The Bearcats play their first 11 games on the road this season
- Northwest will open up with a doubleheader at Montevallo (Ala.) on Sunday
- Northwest returns six position starters and half of its starting rotation from 2009
