- Blake Bolles passed for a career-high five touchdowns on Saturday against Western.
- LaRon Council rushed for a career-high 192 yards, and added two touchdowns last week.
- WR Jake Soy had nine catches for a career-high 142 yards and three touchdowns against Western.
- Last season Northwest defeated Missouri Southern 48-24.

Volleyball (10-11 / 1-4 MIAA)

- Sara Falcone was named to the Lady Blue's Fall Classic all-tournament team this past weekend.
- Northwest split over the weekend 2-2.
- Central Missouri is No. 5 and UNO is No. 15 in the latest AVCA Poll.

Soccer (7-3-3/ 3-3-1 MIAA)

- Kira Lazenby recorded 12 saves (one shy of career-high) in Northwest's 0-0 draw with Central Missouri.
- Shannon FitzGerald recorded her first goal of the season last weekend against UNO.
- Northwest lost both matches against Washburn last season; went 1-1 against Emporia.
- Sara Meidlinger and Kelsey Sanders each have three assists to lead the Bearcats.

Golf

Cross Country

- Northwest women won, and the men placed second at Emporia State on Oct. 2.
- First meet victory for Northwest outside of their own since 1997.
- Angela Adams finished second in a time of 18:45.18 – the ninth fastest five-kilometer time in Northwest history.
- T.R. Pursell was fourth with a time of 25:48.49 in his eight-kilometer run.
