## About the Instructors

### HEAD COACH DARIN LOE

After five successful seasons, Darin Loe continues his preparation for his sixth season as the head baseball coach at Northwest Missouri State University. Loe's team in 2003 went 36-17 and was a third place finisher in the Midwest region.

With an impressive baseball background, the former Seattle Mariner comes to Maryville after spending six years in Midwest collegiate coaching. At Baker University in Baldwin City, Kan., Coach Loe led the Wildcats to two Heart of America Athletics Conference tournament championships in 1997 and 1998, and a third-place regional finish in 1998. He has compiled a 299-261 career coaching record in 11 seasons as a head coach.

Prior to his tenure at Baker University, he was the head coach at NAIA member Missouri Valley College in Marshall, Mo., for three seasons. In his final season at Missouri Valley, he led the Vikings to their first HAAC tournament appearance. Loe began his coaching career as an assistant coach at North Dakota State University. He was a dominating pitcher at Valley City State University in Valley City, N.D., and holds many pitching records such as wins in a season, career wins, strikeouts in a season, strikeouts in a career. He also led the nation in strikeouts in 1987.

At the culmination of his college career, Loe was drafted by the Seattle Mariners in the 26th round of the 1989 amateur draft, and played three seasons in the Mariners organization before entering the coaching ranks.

### ASSISTANT COACH MATT JOHNSON

Matt was a four-year starter at Valley City State University of Valley City, N.D., at the catcher position. He was a three-year all-conference player and an All-American his senior year. Following college, Matt played for one year for the Fargo-Moorhead Redhawks of the Independent Northern League Central. he was then picked up by the Allentown Ambassadors of the Northern League East as a free agent last year. Matt is now working full time at Northwest as director of the campus fitness center and assistant baseball coach. He is in charge of catchers and hitters and is the Bearcat Baseball recruiting coordinator.

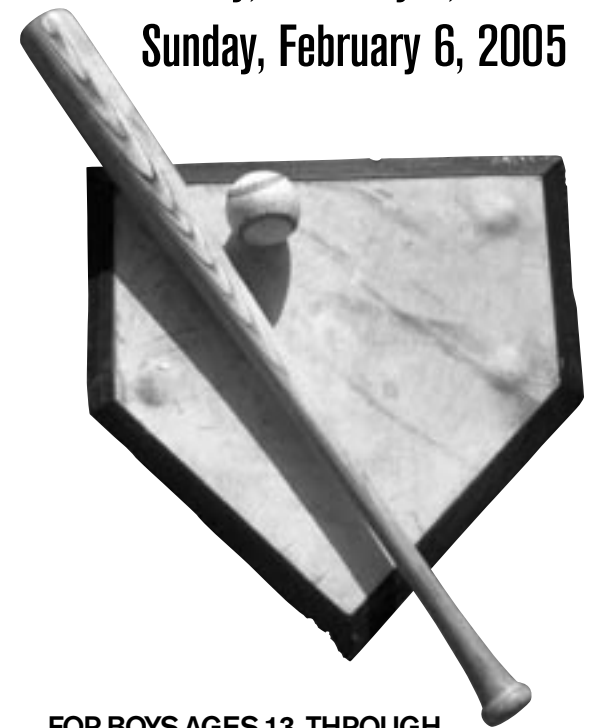

# Bearcat Baseball Clinic

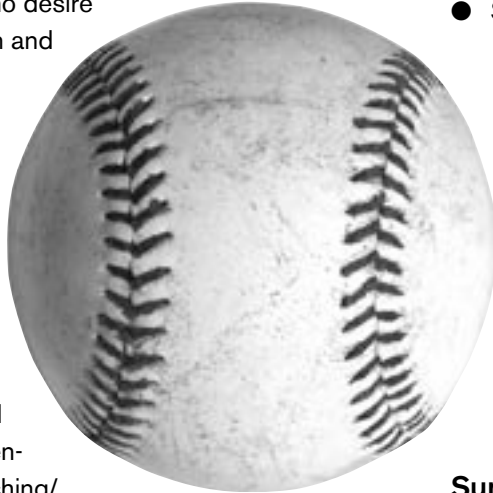
Sharpen your baseball skills in February and be ready for the game this spring and summer.
