Bearcat Notes

- 1 Northwest was receiving votes in the Collegiate Baseball Magazine/ ABCA national poll March 9 for the first time since March 24, 2008.
- 2 Northwest will recognize seven players and two coaches between games one and two Saturday as they participate in the final Northwest games this weekend. Graduate Assistant Cameron Dodd and Student Assistant Britt Westman will be honored along with seniors Chris Benham, Bill Disselhoff, Jared Erspamer, Jeff Gradel, Jr., Bret Harvel, Jacob Kemper and Danny Malone.
- 3 Northwest has played seven extra-inning games through the first 47 contests of the season with a 5-2 record in those games. No other MIAA team has played more than four extra-inning games this season and Pittsburg State is the only team in the league to have played no extra-inning games.
- 4 Brandon Kirsch earned his first career MIAA Player of the Week honor after he hit .389 with five home runs and 14 RBIs in five games last week. Northwest has had at least one Player of the Week every year since 2006.
- 5 The Bearcats are on a season-best six-game win streak, their longest since winning seven straight games Feb. 24-29, 2008. A sweep of the series would provide the longest winning streak since an 11-game stretch from April 15-May 2, 2006.
- 6 Bret Harvel picked up his fourth career shutout and lowered his season earned run average by 32 points to 2.99 in the final game of the Southwest Baptist series April 25.
- 7 Jacob Kemper is fourth among MIAA pitchers, 22nd in Division II and fifth in program season records with seven saves this season. Kemper is holding opponents to a .240 batting average in his 17 appearances.
- 8 Bill Disselhoff threw the first nine-inning complete game for the Bearcats since Joel Epley did so against Southwest Baptist March 17, 2007.

- 9 Jeff Gradel, Jr., threw a career-high nine strikeouts in his first complete game of the season to open the SBU series April 24. Gradel is averaging 6.49 strikeouts per nine-inning contest.
- 10 The Bearcats have hit two grand slams this season, the most since 2005. Brandon Kirsch hit a grand slam against Fort Hays State (game one) and Trevor Conner hit one against Central Missouri (game two).
- 11 Trent Kohlstaedt has made a team-leading 25 appearances this season through the first 47 games of the season. He needs one more to tie Troy Newman's 26 appearances in 1985 for second in program records.
- 12 Brandon Kirsch moved himself into fourth in program career records with his five home runs against the purple Bearcats last weekend. He stands with 29 career homers, one short of Scott Spurgeon's 30 in 1987-88.
- 13 Matt Stice stole five bases against Southwest Baptist last weekend and carries a three-game stolen bases streak into the final series of the season. Stice is fourth in the MIAA and eighth in season records with 24. He's six away from tying John Bothof for fourth in program records.

Head Coach Darin Loe



Darin Loe begins his 10th season at Northwest Missouri State and 16th as a head coach in 2009. He's produced seven consecutive winning seasons at Northwest, the longest streak in program history since Jim Wasem's 10-season streak from 1973-82.

Loe narrowly missed his fifth 30-win season in 2008 after the Bearcats went 29-22 in a fifth-place finish in the MIAA.

The 2007 campaign marked a 30-26 season that ended with a third-place finish in the MIAA tournament. Loe also passed Wasem for second in all-time wins with a 3-1 victory against Emporia State April 15.

In nine seasons, Loe has placed five players on the All-MIAA First Team and 26 players on the second team. Under Loe, 51 players have received first-team, second-team or honorable mention All-MIAA honors.

The 2003 season was Loe's most successful as a Bearcat when he led the team to a second-place conference finish and a berth in the NCAA Division II South Central Regional Tournament. It was the first time the Bearcats had qualified for regional play since 1989.

When he came to Northwest in 2000, Loe took over a struggling program, turned it around and has since guided the Bearcats to two third-place and one second-place finish in the MIAA in his nine seasons as the Bearcat skipper.

Loe led Northwest to MIAA Tournament berths in four of his first five years at Northwest. In 2003, the team's 36 wins was the second-highest victory total in school history behind the record 42 wins in 1989.

Before coming to Northwest, Loe was the head coach at Baker University in Baldwin City, Kan. While at Baker, he led the Wildcats to two Heart of America Athletic Conference tournament championships in 1997 and 1998 and a third-place regional finish in 1998.

Loe earned his first head coaching position at Missouri Valley College in Marshall, Mo., in 1994. In three seasons, he led the Vikings to their first HAAC tournament appearance.

Loe was a dominating pitcher at Valley City State University in Valley City, N.D., and holds program records in season wins, career wins (28), season strikeouts (121) and career strikeouts (380). He led the NAIA in strikeouts in 1987. He was also a standout quarterback for the Vikings and entered the Valley City State Hall of Fame in October 2001.

At the culmination of his college career, Loe was drafted by the Seattle Mariners in the 26th round of the 1989 amateur draft. He played three seasons in the Mariner's organization before entering the coaching ranks.

Loe attained his bachelor's degree from Valley City State University in 1991 and a master's degree from North Dakota State University in the spring of 1994 where he served as an assistant coach.

Loe and his wife, Lisa, reside in Maryville with their daughters Abby (9), Macy (6) and son Cooper (4).
