This Week in Cross Country

Both Northwest Missouri State Cross Country teams will travel to Pittsburg, Kan., for the MIAA Championships on Sat. Oct. 22, with races beginning at 10:30 A.M. Both teams were off last week, after participating in the Concordia Invitational in Seward, Neb., on Oct. 8.

Women's Notes

Freshman **Anna O'Brien** (Easton, Mo.) finished sixth overall at the Concordia Invitational and first for Northwest, running a time of 19:36 in the 5K race. O'Brien has placed first for Northwest in all five races this season, while her run in Concordia marked her third top-10 overall finish this season. O'Brien also holds the fourth fastest time in school history for a 6K race, where she ran 23:23 at the Woody Greeno/UNL Invite on Sept. 17. **Karah Spader** (York, Neb.) finished seventh in Concordia with 19:37, finishing second for Northwest for the fifth race this season. Freshman **Maggie McManigal** (Colorado Springs, Colo.) placed third for the Bearcats in Concordia, finishing 14th overall with a time of 20:31. McManigal also finished 94th in the Loyola Lakefront Invitational (Oct. 1) and 31st in the CU/UNO Invitational (Sept. 3). The women's team is currently ranked ninth in the South Central Region of the Oct. 10 poll of the Division II Cross Country Coaches Association.

Men's Notes

Junior **Matt Pohren** (Omaha, Neb.) finished sixth overall in the Concordia Invitational, running 26:41 in the 8K race, his third top finish for Northwest this season. Pohren also finished second for the Bearcats and third overall at the Dean White Invitational on Sept. 24, 13th overall in the CMSU Mule Run (Sept. 9) and 65th at Woody Greeno (Sept. 17). Junior **Drew Wilson** (Stanton, Iowa) earned MIAA Runner of the Week honors for the week of Sept. 26, for his first place overall finish at the Dean White Invite. **Brandon Dart** (Fremont, Neb.) finished second for Northwest and ninth overall in the Concordia Invite with a time of 27:04. The men's team is currently ranked seventh in the South Central Region of the Oct. 10 poll of the Division II Cross Country Coaches Association.

Coaching Staff

Men's head coach **Richard Alsup** is in his 29th year at Northwest Missouri State, while **Scott Lorek** logs his second year as head coach for the women's team.

Alsup led the Bearcats to the Great Lakes Regional Championship and a second place finish in the MIAA Championships in 1998, the first time Northwest had won a regional title in men's cross country. He was also awarded the MIAA Cross Country Coach of the Year in 1997, and MIAA Track and Field Coach of the Year three times. Lorek led the Bearcats to a sixth place finish at the 2004 MIAA Championships in his first year at Northwest.

Previously, Lorek worked at Western State (Colo.) as the head men's and women's track and field coach. At Western, he led the team to a second-place finish in the NCAA Division II Outdoor Championships in 2002, and finished third in 2004. He was named the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference Women's Indoor and Outdoor Coach of the Year in 2001.

Before working at Western State, Lorek was the head men's and women's track and field/cross country coach at Wittenberg University in Ohio for two seasons. He was also an assistant coach at Butler University (Ind.) for one season in 1996-97, and the head women's track and field/cross country coach at the University of Idaho for 11 years.
