Bearcats are Back Into Action After a Week Off

This Week

The Northwest Missouri State men's and women's cross country teams will be splitting up this week as the men travel to Chicago for the Sean Earl Loyola Lakefront Run, and the women will be traveling to Minneapolis for the Roy Griak Invitational. The women's run will take place at the Les Bolstad Golf Course at 9:45 a.m. and the men's run will be at Montrose Beach at 1 p.m.

Men's Notes

The Bearcats competed against over 600 runners and three Division I schools last meet in the Woody Greeno Invitational in Lincoln, Neb. The men competed in the 8K and finished in 14th place out of 21 teams with a total of 322 team points. Sophomore **Ben Chappell** finished first for Northwest for the second straight week and 66th overall with a time of 27:07.35. Freshmen **T.R. Pursell** finished second for Northwest and 73rd overall with a time of 27:19.85.

Women's Notes

The women were led by junior **Anna O'Brien** last meet to an eighth-place finish in the 6K race with 210 team points. O'Brien finished in 30th place with a time of 23:25.55, improving her time from last year by 43.3 seconds. Senior **Karah Spader** finished second for the Bearcats and 52nd overall with a mark of 24:00.10.

The Northwest Cross Country teams, will be traveling to Memphis, Tenn., to compete in the Brooks Memphis Twilight Classic, which is scheduled to take place in the Mike Rose Soccer Complex at 10:10 a.m.
