Quick Hits

Northwest has won 14 straight games against Emporia State dating back to 1995 and leads the all-time series 23-2. The Bearcats are 11-1 all-time in Emporia (only loss came in 1965).

Northwest has won 10 of the last 11 meetings with Emporia State by at least two touchdowns. Seven of those wins were by more than 30 points.

LaRon Council needs 81 yards to become the fifth 3,000-yard running back in program history

Northwest currently ranks in the top 10 nationally in kickoff return average (first), scoring (second), turnover margin (second), sacks (fourth), passing efficiency (sixth) and total defense (10th)

Jake Soy's 14 touchdown receptions lead the nation. Only three players (two RBs and one QB) have scored more touchdowns in DII.

Soy is two touchdown receptions away from tying Tony Miles' Northwest single-season record of 16 set in 1998.

The Bearcats have won 36 consecutive games (33 in MIAA play) against MIAA teams including playoff wins against Washburn in 2005 and against Pittsburg State in 2005 and 2008

Bearcat Notes

1 Northwest and Emporia State have met every year since 1991. The Bearcats have won 17 of the 18 games with the exception being a 41-26 decision in Maryville in 1994.

2 Emporia State's only lead against Northwest in its last 10 games came in 2003 when the Hornets' first-quarter touchdown held until late in the third quarter. The Bearcats eventually won 16-13.

3 Northwest's senior class is 45-6 overall and 32-0 in MIAA play in their four seasons as a Bearcat. There are 25 teams in Division II that have incurred six losses through seven weeks this season.

4 Northwest remains third behind undefeated Abilene Christian and Central Washington in the latest regional rankings released this week by the NCAA.

5 Northwest leads the league in 10 of the 30 team statistical categories released by the MIAA and are second in another seven. Scoring defense, total defense, pass defense, rush defense, pass efficiency defense, sacks and interceptions are among the 10 categories the Bearcats rank first.

6 Northwest's schedule is currently ranked as the fifth toughest in the nation by the NCAA. The Bearcats' past opponents hold a combined record of 25-14 (.641) and their future opponents are currently 16-12 (.571).

7 The Bearcats have won 37 of their last 40 regular season games dating back to 2005. The team's three losses in that span came in the season openers of the 2007, 2008 and 2009 seasons.

8 Northwest has won six straight games since falling to Abilene Christian in its season opener. The Bearcats have enjoyed a win streak of at least six games in 12 of their last 14 seasons (exceptions: 2003, 2005)

9 The Bearcats lead the nation in kickoff returns (28.2 ypr) and two freshmen are the main reason why. Tyler Shaw and Jordan Simmons have returned all but three kicks this season. Shaw is averaging 35.8 yards per return and has a 92-yard touchdown this season. Simmons is averaging 24.8 yards per return. Northwest's average drive this season has started at its 38-yard line.

Shaw is Northwest's second-leading receiver with 24 catches for 313 yards and three scores. Simmons is the Bearcats' third-leading rusher with 24 carries for 113 yards.

10 Northwest quarterback Blake Bolles' 21 touchdown tosses this season are six shy of the Bearcats' regular-season mark set by Greg Teale in 1995. Bolles' 28 career touchdown passes rank ninth in program history. Joel Osborn is eighth on that list with 39.

11 Bolles has passed for 799 yards and 12 touchdowns in his last six quarters of play (three games). Bolles did not play in the second half against Truman nor Missouri Southern. Bolles has been intercepted once in his last 109 pass attempts.

12 Sophomore wide out Jake Soy has caught 20 passes for 349 yards and nine touchdowns in his last three games. His four touchdown receptions last week against Missouri Southern is a program record.

13 Council scored his 50th collegiate touchdown two weeks ago against Missouri Western. He needs one more to tie David Jansen for second place on Northwest's career touchdowns scored list. Only Jansen (306), Tommy Frevert (386), David Purnell (400) and Xavier Omon (590) have scored more points at Northwest.

14 Sean Paddock's foot injury kept him out of last week's game, his first missed game in his four-year career which ended a string of 35 consecutive starts. Paddock, Northwest's all-time leader in sacks, will not play Saturday at Emporia State.

15 Only two teams in the nation have more sacks than the 26 made by the Bearcats this season. Fifteen Northwest players have registered a sack.

16 Northwest has two sacks in its last two games without the services of Sean Paddock (24 in its first five games).

17 Northwest has won five of six coin tosses this season. The Bearcats lost the toss to Missouri Western and the Griffons remain the only team to score on their opening drive against the Bearcats.

18 Northwest has scored on its opening drive in each of its last three games (two TDs, one FG).

19 Joe Bedard (#40) had four special-teams tackles against Missouri Southern and leads Northwest with 10 on the year.

20 Northwest is outscoring opponents 133-40 in the second halves of games this season. The Bearcats have allowed seven points in the third quarter.

21 The MIAA is currently the highest scoring conference in the nation as teams combine to average 31.7 points per game. The West Virginia Conference ranks second at 29.4 points the South Atlantic is third at 29.3 points.

22 Northwest is 121-11 when scoring first (.917), 129-11 when leading at halftime (.921) and 137-10 when leading after three quarters (.932) under Tjeerdsma.

23 Three backs have rushed for 100 yards against Northwest in the last 55 games. Two QBs have broken 100 in that span. In nearly half of the 55 games (27), starting running backs failed to rush for 50 yards.

Coaches, Media Pick Northwest to Repeat

Northwest Missouri State, the national runner-up the last four seasons, has been picked to win its fourth consecutive MIAA championship by the league's head coaches and media as announced Monday during the league's media day at the Marriott Hotel.

The Bearcats have been predicted to win the conference crown for the fourth year in a row and for the fifth time in seven seasons. Northwest has proven the coaches right each time, tying for the title in 2003 and winning it outright with unblemished marks the past three seasons.

Northwest received eight of a possible nine first-place votes in the coaches poll (coaches can't vote for their own team) and 42 of 47 first-place votes by the league's media, which conducted a preseason football poll for the first time. The media group consisted of print and television media, radio crews and sports information directors of each institution.

Pittsburg State, the last MIAA team to beat Northwest, is ranked second in both polls and Central Missouri is third. Washburn, Missouri Western and Nebraska-Omaha are 4-5-6 in the coaches poll. Nebraska-Omaha and Washburn switch positions in the media poll.

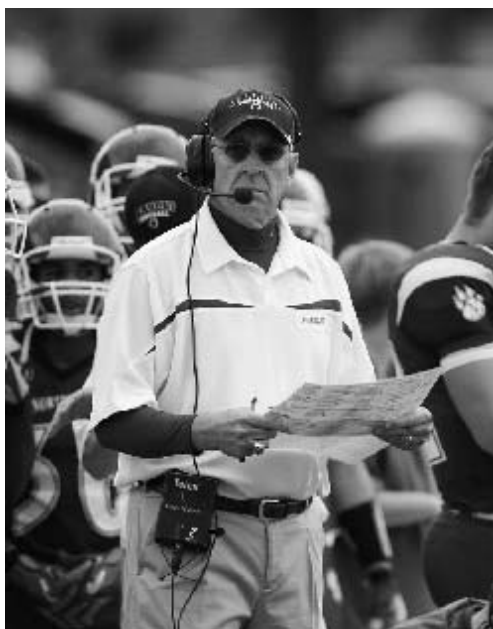
Northwest was ranked in the preseason coaches' poll for the 13th consecutive season.

Northwest began the year ranked in the top 10 for the 11th time and in the top five for the seventh time.

Northwest has been ranked every week in the AFCA poll since the start of the 2004 season.

The Bearcats are 17-3 when playing as the No. 5 team in the nation.

Head Coach Mel Tjeerdsma



Mel Tjeerdsma, the 2008 American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) Division II Coach of the Year, will begin his 16th season at Northwest Missouri State and his 26th as a collegiate head coach. The winningest coach in program history, Tjeerdsma has guided the Bearcats to 10 MIAA championships, two NCAA national championships and six title game appearances in the last 11 seasons.

Northwest was 0-11 in Tjeerdsma's first season in 1994. The team is 157-30 since.

Four years after his inaugural season with the team, the Bearcats became the first NCAA Division II squad to finish a season 15-0. Northwest won back-to-back national championships in 1998 and 1999. It was the University's first national titles in any sport. Tjeerdsma was named AFCA Coach of the Year following both of his championship seasons.

Among his peers in Division II, Tjeerdsma ranks fifth on the active wins list (216) and with the seventh-best win percentage (.732). His 216 wins are the 10th-most in Division II history. Four more wins will place him in a tie for seventh place on that list.

Tjeerdsma has more postseason victories than any other coach in Division II history. He's led Northwest to the playoffs 11 times in the last 13 seasons and

sports a 25-9 postseason record. He's undefeated (6-0) in the semifinal round of the playoffs, 10-1 in opening games and 15-3 at home. Northwest made two first-round exits in its only appearances prior to Tjeerdsma's arrival.

The 2008 Bearcats became the 13th team in program history to go unbeaten in MIAA play. Eight teams under Tjeerdsma have finished 9-0 in league play since 1997.

Following the 2007 season, running back Xavier Omon became the fourth player under Tjeerdsma to be drafted into the NFL. Omon was a sixth-round selection by the Buffalo Bills. Omon joins Chris Greisen (1999), Seth Wand (2003) and Dave Tollefson (2006) as Northwest players drafted after playing for Tjeerdsma. Fifteen Bearcats have either been drafted or have signed NFL contracts during Tjeerdsma's tenure.

Tjeerdsma has been named MIAA Coach of the Year 10 times (1995-2000, 2002, 2006-08). He's been named AFCA Regional Coach of the Year seven times (1996-2000, 2006, 2008).

In addition to his coaching duties, Tjeerdsma served as president of the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) in 2006. It was the first time a Northwest coach has led the AFCA and the first time a Division II general has presided since 1999.

In his 15 years at Northwest, Tjeerdsma's squads have produced 39 All-Americans. Included in the tally are 27 first-team All-Americans and 11 players who earned All-America honors in two or more seasons.

Under Tjeerdsma, Northwest has produced 104 All-MIAA student-athletes, including 68 players who earned first-team honors. Sixty-four players have earned all-region honors with 43 being listed on the first team.

Prior to coaching at Northwest, Tjeerdsma guided Austin College to three Texas Intercollegiate Athletic Association Championships (TIAA) and became the program's all-time winningest coach. The Kangaroos were 59-38-4 in 10 seasons under Tjeerdsma and made two trips to the NAIA Division II playoffs. Tjeerdsma earned three TIAA Coach of the Year awards.

Before his time at Austin, Tjeerdsma was the offensive coordinator at Northwestern College in Orange City, Iowa, for eight years. He also served as the head track and field coach at Northwestern. The Red Raiders earned four trips to the NAIA Division II playoffs and won a national championship in 1983 with Tjeerdsma on staff. His offense twice led the nation in total offense and scoring. His track and field teams won three Tri-State Conference titles and five consecutive NAIA District 15 Indoor Championships.

Prior to his collegiate coaching career, Tjeerdsma served as head football coach at Denison (Iowa) High School, where he guided his team to a 9-0 record and a 1975 state playoff berth.

He earned Northwest Iowa Coach of the Year honors in 1972 after winning a state championship at Sioux Center High School. He was the Northwest Iowa Track and Field Coach of the Year in 1973, 1974 and 1975.

Tjeerdsma earned his bachelor's degree in physical education from Southern (S.D.) State in 1967. He earned his master's degree from Northwest in 1977.

Mel and his wife, Carol, live just outside of Maryville and have three married daughters and seven grandchildren.

MARYVILLE, Mo.—Sixth-ranked Northwest Missouri State scored touchdowns on eight of 13 offensive possessions en route to a 70-0 win against Truman in the 75th battle for the Old Hickory Stick. Truman ran 31 offensive plays in the first half that netted four yards. The Bulldogs finished with 92 yards with 62 coming on an empty fourth-quarter possession. Truman completed four passes in the contest for 45 yards. Northwest sacked Truman quarterback Taylor Breen eight times for 65 yards. Sean Paddock got his 25th career sack on the second play of the game, making him the Bearcats' all-time leader. Northwest freshman receiver Tyler Shaw scored Northwest's first two touchdowns and finished with three. He caught a 14-yard touchdown pass from Blake Bolles, recovered a blocked punt in the end zone and ran the opening kick of the second half 92 yards. It was the first collegiate scores for Shaw.
