Bearcat Notes

1 Northwest will have 28 active players on the roster in 2008 - the largest team in program history. Shannon FitzGerald will take a medical redshirt (knee).

2 Forward Amanda Deml, midfielder Heidi Sobota and defender Jessica Braun were selected as captains by a vote of their teammates.

3 Goalkeeper Kira Lazenby broke Northwest's single-season shutout record after logging her fifth of the season in a double-overtime tie with Missouri Western. She picked up her sixth shutout of the season against Emporia State Oct. 24 and needs one more to tie for second in career records.

4 Andrea Tritz became the first Bearcat in program history to score a goal in four consecutive games with a goal in 49th minute against Wayne State Sept. 7.

5 Holly Ramaeaker became the fourth Bearcat in program history to score three goals in one game and the first since 2006. Ramaeaker scored all three Bearcat goals against Missouri Western Sept. 13 in the second half, two coming off of penalty kicks.

6 After starting the season with a program-record four straight wins, and picking up four more wins during the MIAA season, the Bearcats need two more to break the season record of nine set in 2006.

7 Andrea Tritz scored the quickest opening goal in program history in the second minute against Emporia State Oct. 23, to improve her season point total to 16 (seven goals, two assists). Two points against Missouri Southern will tie the school record set by Beth Gutschenritter in 2004.

8 Missouri Southern is on a five-game winless streak since Oct. 4 and haven't won at home since the season-opening game against Abilene Christian Aug. 29.

9 Kira Lazenby is on pace to set the season save percentage and goal against average mark. Her .847 save percentage is surpassing Kathie Leach's mark of .832 set in 1999 and her 0.93 goals against average is below Alison Sheridan's 1.33 average of 2005.

10 Junior transfer Megan Pfile grew up in Wasilla, Alaska, the same town that Republican Vice-Presidential candidate Sarah Palin served as mayor for from 1996-2002.

11 The top three teams in the NCAA South Central Regional Rankings are MIAA squads: Central Missouri, Truman and Washburn. The top six teams between the MIAA, Lone Star Conference and Heartland Conference advance to the NCAA postseason.

12 Northwest saw a program-record eight-game scoring streak end against Southwest Baptist Sept. 20. The Bearcats outscored opponents 15-4 in the span. The Bearcats surpassed their previous best of six games set in 2005.

Head Coach Tracy Hoza



The all-time winningest coach in Northwest soccer history, Tracy Hoza begins her sixth season as the head coach for the Bearcat program.

Hoza returns six starters from last year's team, which held opponents to three shutouts and a program record 171 shots. She also saw the first Bearcat named to a CoSIDA Academic All-District team in Amanda Deml.

In 2006, she led the Bearcats to the most wins in a season and best win-loss percentage in Northwest history. That season also saw the first regional ranking, as Northwest reached as high as seventh on Oct. 3.

Hoza comes to Northwest from Toledo (Ohio) University, where she served as an assistant with the NCAA Division I program for two seasons. During her two years with the

Rockets, they compiled a 14-18-3 record.

Prior to her time at Toledo, Hoza was the assistant coach at Lock Haven (Pa.) University. She helped the Lady Eagles to a 32-6-3 mark in two seasons as the assistant coach at Lock Haven. In addition, Lock Haven won two Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference championships while Hoza was an assistant there. The Lady Eagles advanced to the 1999 NCAA Division II Sweet 16 in 1999, while taking one more step to the Elite Eight in 2000.

A 1995 graduate of Mercyhurst (Pa.), Hoza was a four-year letterwinner for the Lakers during her collegiate career. The Limerick, Ireland native earned NSCAA All-America honors following the 1994 and 1995 seasons. Hoza was a three-time All-Region honoree and captained the Lakers' 1994 NCAA Division II Final Four team. She also played for the Irish Junior and Senior National Teams from 1987-1991.

Hoza holds her undergraduate degree from Mercyhurst in sports medicine. She received her master's degree in liberal arts from Lock Haven.
