HOMESTAND ENDS WITH TSU, MWSU

Northwest Missouri State will play the final four games of a 13-game homestand this weekend as the Bearcats welcome Truman (10-25, 2-8 MIAA) to Bearcat Field Friday and 25th-ranked Missouri Western (35-6, 8-2) Saturday. Game one of scheduled doubleheaders will begin at 3 p.m. Friday and 1 p.m. Saturday.

Northwest's five seniors -- Megan Simpson, Cola Krueger, Amber Corkins, Casey Carper and Tiffany Carter -- will be recognized in a pregame ceremony Saturday.

The Bearcats sit one game behind Fort Hays State in a bid for the final spot in the MIAA tournament (April 30 - May 2) with four doubleheaders remaining. Northwest wraps up its regular season schedule next weekend.

Truman enters play having lost 14 of its last 16 games. The Bulldogs are batting a meager-.220 as a team with five home runs. Truman hasn't scored more than two runs in any of its last five games.

Missouri Western has ridden the arm of Allison Jones, who at 19-1 has the second-best record in the nation. Her 1.54 ERA ranks 42nd nationally.

The Griffons' saw an incredible 32-game win streak come to an abrupt halt last weekend with two losses to Central Missouri in St. Joseph. Scores were 4-0 and 9-1.

While Missouri Western's has nine players who've started either all 41 games or all but one game, the Bearcats are down to one player on their bench. A back injury to the team's second-leading hitter, Casey Carper, means four players are out for the season while pitcher Kelsey Resa's status is uncertain following a line drive to the head last week against Rockhurst.

TEAM & PLAYER NOTES

- ▶ The 2009 season is the 35th in the history of Northwest softball
- ▶ The MIAA has moved from the North Central Region to the South Central Region in softball for the 2009 season. The South Central Region includes the MIAA, Lone Star and Heartland Conferences.
- ▶ As a result, Northwest is scheduled to play six teams from the Lone Star Conference and two from the Heartland Conference during the regular season.
- ▶ Of the Bearcats 19 non-conference opponents on the 2009 schedule, four were NCAA qualifiers a year ago, 14 had winning records last season, five won 40 games or more and two won 53 games.
- ▶ Junior third baseman Kaila Ballard and freshman infielder Hailee Hendricks will both redshirt the 2009 season due to injury. Ballard started 52 of 54 games last season. She hit .279 with two home runs, 29 RBIs and 15 runs scored.
- ▶ Northwest returns nine letterwinners from last year's team, including five positional starters and one starting pitcher.
- ▶ Three of the Bearcats top four hitters return to the lineup in senior outfielder Casey Carper (.411), junior second baseman Erin Leslie (.388) and senior catcher Tiffany Carter (.309).
- ▶ Carper was a first-team all-region outfielder in 2008. Leslie was a unanimous first-team all-MIAA second baseman.
- ▶ Northwest's 1-0 loss against Cameron back on March 6 was the first time the Bearcats had been kept scoreless in 30 games dating back to last season.
- ▶ Tiffany Carter currently leads the MIAA in RBIs with 45 in 43 games. She needs four to tie Northwest's single-season record, which she set last season.
- ▶ Carter's 10 home runs this season are tied for second in the MIAA and are the third-most hit by a player in program history. Only Lindsay Stephenson (15, 2006) and Ashley Pride (11, 2006) have hit more.
- ▶ Erin Leslie leads Northwest and ranks fifth in the MIAA with 31 runs scored. She's scored six runs in the team's last three games.
- ▶ Carter and Jennifer Bohle's three-game hitting streaks are currently the longest on the team. Carter had a team-best 10-game hitting streak earlier this season.
- ▶ Northwest is 7-0 when leading after six innings and 0-22 when trailing after six (3-3 when tied).
- ▶ Amber Corkins' RBI single in the bottom of the seventh inning against Fort Hays State was the Bearcats' first walk-off hit this season and the team's first since April 22, 2007 (Kristin Hessel).
- ▶ Exactly half of Corkins' 22 hits this season have come in conference play where she's batting .344 with two home runs and nine RBI.
- ▶ Northwest leads Truman 48-35 and Missouri Western 44-39 in all-time series records. The Griffons' swept the Bearcats earlier this season in St. Joseph.
- ▶ Carter was 3-for-5 with a home run and three RBIs during a twin bill with the Griffons earlier this season.
- ▶ Missouri Western is the fifth nationally-ranked team the Bearcats will face this season. Northwest is 1-5 against ranked teams.

HEAD COACH RYAN ANDERSON



Ryan Anderson, who led the Bearcats to their second NCAA regional tournament in three seasons, begins his third year at Northwest. Anderson has combined for 57 wins in his first two seasons – good for fourth all-time in program history. His winning percentage of .588 currently sits second.

Anderson enjoyed three winning streaks of six games or more in leading his team to a 32-22 record in 2008. Northwest tied for the MIAA lead in runs per game (5.2) and placed third in both the league's regular season standings and postseason tournament. The Bearcats earned their fourth-ever bid to the NCAA tournament and picked up their third postseason win, defeating Central Missouri 1-0.

The Bearcats' 32 wins in 2008 are the fourth-most in program history. Anderson posted 25 wins against 18 losses in his first season in 2007.

Prior to his arrival in Maryville, Anderson spent successful seasons at the University of Missouri-Rolla, leading the Lady Miners to a 107-49 record – the best three-season stretch in program history. Anderson's teams broke more than 20 records and achieved the school's first recognition in nationwide rankings.

Anderson led UMR to a program-record 41 wins in 2004. The Lady Miners finished second in the regular season race and third in the MIAA Tournament. The team also had the MIAA's most valuable player in pitcher Christy Daken, the first of four all-region players who performed for the Lady Miners under Anderson's tutelage. That record-setting season was followed by a 33-25 campaign in 2005 and a mark of 33-10 in 2006, UMR's first season as a member of the Great Lakes Valley Conference (GLVC).

Prior to Missouri-Rolla, Anderson was the head softball coach for the University of Minnesota-Crookston in 2003 when he led the team to a school record for conference wins in a season.

A native of Colby, Kan., Anderson received his bachelor's degree in sports administration with a minor in business administration from the University of Nebraska-Kearney in 1999. He spent three years as an assistant softball coach at UNK upon graduation. During that time, he also served as marketing and promotions assistant for the Athletics Department.

Anderson and his wife, Ashley, reside in Maryville with their infant son, Owen.
