## WELCOME HOME BEARCATS

Not many sports would have you play 34 games before stepping foot on your home field. Unfortunately softball is one of them.

Northwest Missouri State will play its entire home slate - seven doubleheaders - in the next 15 days starting this weekend with twin bills against Washburn (Friday) and Emporia State (Saturday). Start times are 3 p.m. Friday and 1 p.m. Saturday.

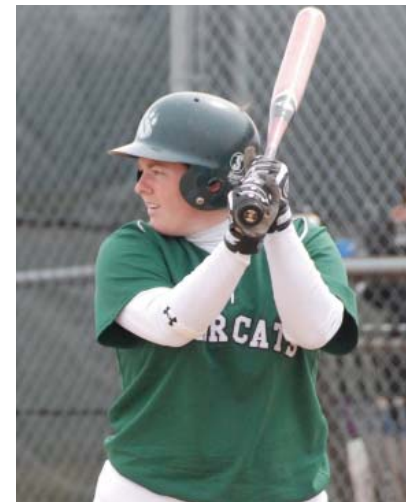
Of the seven home doubleheaders, six will be against conference teams. Of the team's final 18 regular season games, just four will be played outside of Maryville.

Washburn is coming off two losses last weekend against Missouri Western, a team that has won 26 straight games. The Lady Blues have won their last five games with the Bearcats, including a two-game sweep of Northwest last season in Maryville.

Northwest was one of three conference teams to take a game from Emporia State last season. The Hornets won both the MIAA regular season and tournament titles before finishing as the national runner-up.

The Hornets (19-8, 0-0 MIAA) begin conference play Friday at Nebraska-Omaha before meeting the Bearcats Saturday. Northwest and Emporia State have split their two conference games in each of the last two seasons.

**Forecast:** Friday's forecast calls for a high of 58 with mostly sunny skies and little chance of rain. Saturday is calling for a 60-percent chance of thunderstorms with a high of 59 and wind gusts near 25 mph.

# TEAM & PLAYER NOTES

- ▶ The 2009 season is the 35th in the history of Northwest softball
- ▶ The MIAA has moved from the North Central Region to the South Central Region in softball for the 2009 season. The South Central Region includes the MIAA, Lone Star and Heartland Conferences.
- ▶ As a result, Northwest is scheduled to play six teams from the Lone Star Conference and two from the Heartland Conference during the regular season.
- ▶ Of the Bearcats 19 non-conference opponents on the 2009 schedule, four were NCAA qualifiers a year ago, 14 had winning records last season, five won 40 games or more and two won 53 games.
- ▶ Junior third baseman Kaila Ballard and freshman infielder Hailee Hendricks will both redshirt the 2009 season due to injury. Ballard started 52 of 54 games last season. She hit .279 with two home runs, 29 RBIs and 15 runs scored.
- ▶ Northwest returns nine letterwinners from last year's team, including five positional starters and one starting pitcher.
- ▶ Three of the Bearcats top four hitters return to the lineup in senior outfielder Casey Carper (.411), junior second baseman Erin Leslie (.388) and senior catcher Tiffany Carter (.309).
- ▶ Carper was a first-team all-region outfielder in 2008. Leslie was a unanimous first-team all-MIAA second baseman.
- ▶ Northwest's 1-0 loss against Cameron back on March 6 was the first time the Bearcats had been kept scoreless in 30 games dating back to last season.
- ▶ Northwest improved to 6-1 in its last seven conference openers following its win against Missouri Southern last Friday.
- ▶ Northwest has scored 29 first-inning runs in 34 games.
- ▶ Northwest scored 18 runs on 43 hits in its first four conference games.
- ▶ Freshman Lauren Peters, who started the first 20 games of the season in left field for the Bearcats, will miss the rest of the season with a leg injury.
- ▶ Amber Corkins recorded her second three-RBI game at Northwest with her three-run HR against Pittsburg State. Her first came in last year's doubleheader with PSU when she went 3-for-4 with a homer and two doubles.
- ▶ Senior pitcher Cola Krueger had a season-high nine strikeouts while pitching a two-hit shutout against Missouri Southern last Friday. It was Krueger's first shutout this season and the 15th of her collegiate career.
- ▶ Freshman Jennifer Bohle has hit safely in 10 of her last 13 games, batting .400 in that span (14-for-35).
- ▶ Juniors Erin Leslie (2B) and Kristen Hessel (C) are the only two players who have started all 34 games at one position this season.
- ▶ Senior Casey Carper and junior Sarah Saladino hit safely in all four MIAA games last weekend. Carper is batting .455 when leading off an inning.
- ▶ Senior Tiffany Carter is batting a team-best .410 (16-of-39) with runners in scoring position. Carter set a program record with 49 RBIs last season. She has 34 in 34 games this season.

## HEAD COACH RYAN ANDERSON

Ryan Anderson, who led the Bearcats to their second NCAA regional tournament in three seasons, begins his third year at Northwest. Anderson has combined for 57 wins in his first two seasons – good for fourth all-time in program history. His winning percentage of .588 currently sits second.



Anderson enjoyed three winning streaks of six games or more in leading his team to a 32-22 record in 2008. Northwest tied for the MIAA lead in runs per game (5.2) and placed third in both the league's regular season standings and postseason tournament. The Bearcats earned their fourth-ever bid to the NCAA tournament and picked up their third postseason win, defeating Central Missouri 1-0.

The Bearcats' 32 wins in 2008 are the fourth-most in program history. Anderson posted 25 wins against 18 losses in his first season in 2007.

Prior to his arrival in Maryville, Anderson spent successful seasons at the University of Missouri-Rolla, leading the Lady Miners to a 107-49 record – the best three-season stretch in program history. Anderson's teams broke more than 20 records and achieved the school's first recognition in nationwide rankings.

Anderson led UMR to a program-record 41 wins in 2004. The Lady Miners finished second in the regular season race and third in the MIAA Tournament. The team also had the MIAA's most valuable player in pitcher Christy Daken, the first of four all-region players who performed for the Lady Miners under Anderson's tutelage. That record-setting season was followed by a 33-25 campaign in 2005 and a mark of 33-10 in 2006, UMR's first season as a member of the Great Lakes Valley Conference (GLVC).

Prior to Missouri-Rolla, Anderson was the head softball coach for the University of Minnesota-Crookston in 2003 when he led the team to a school record for conference wins in a season.

A native of Colby, Kan., Anderson received his bachelor's degree in sports administration with a minor in business administration from the University of Nebraska-Kearney in 1999. He spent three years as an assistant softball coach at UNK upon graduation. During that time, he also served as marketing and promotions assistant for the Athletics Department.

Anderson and his wife, Ashley, reside in Maryville with their infant son, Owen.

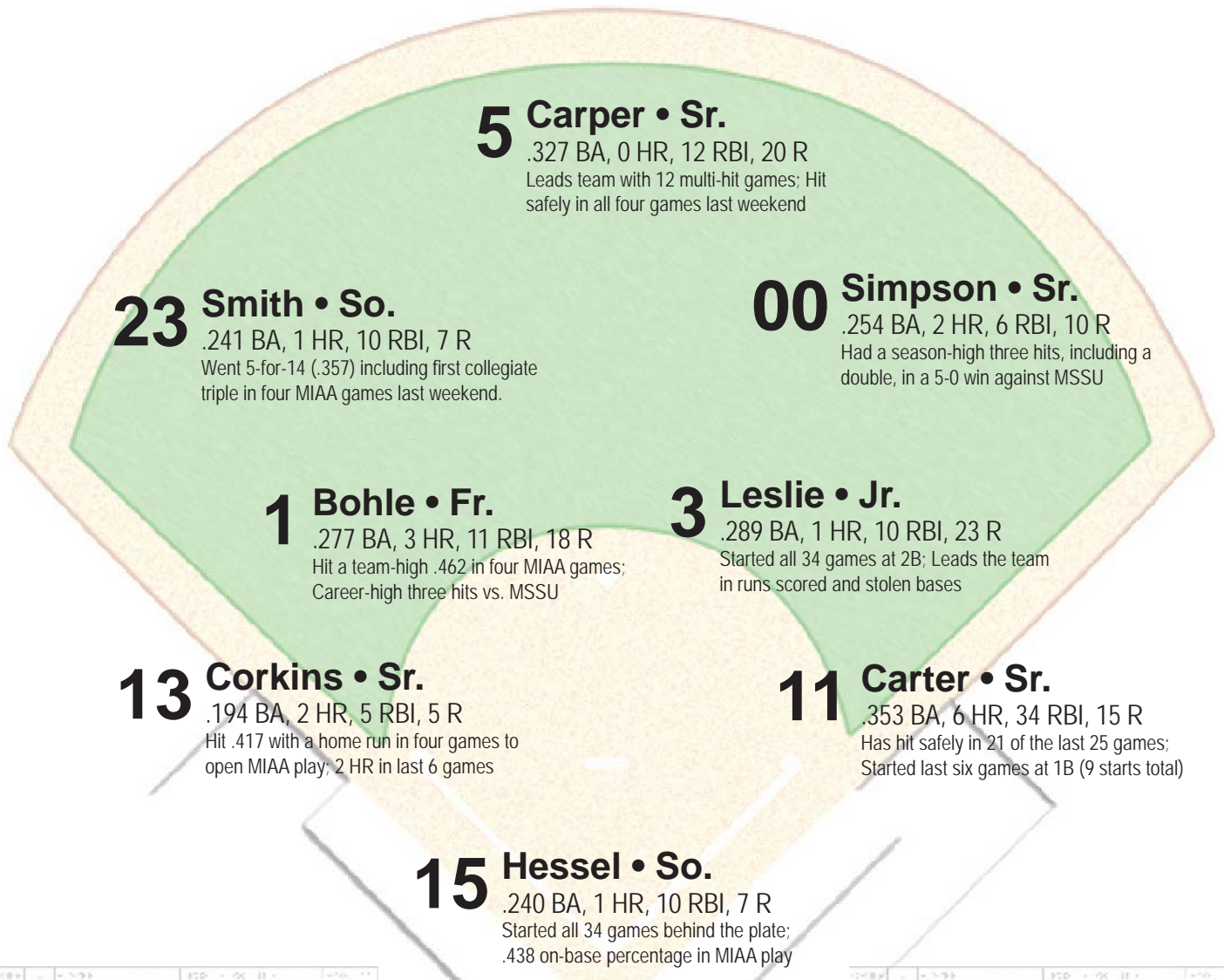
