



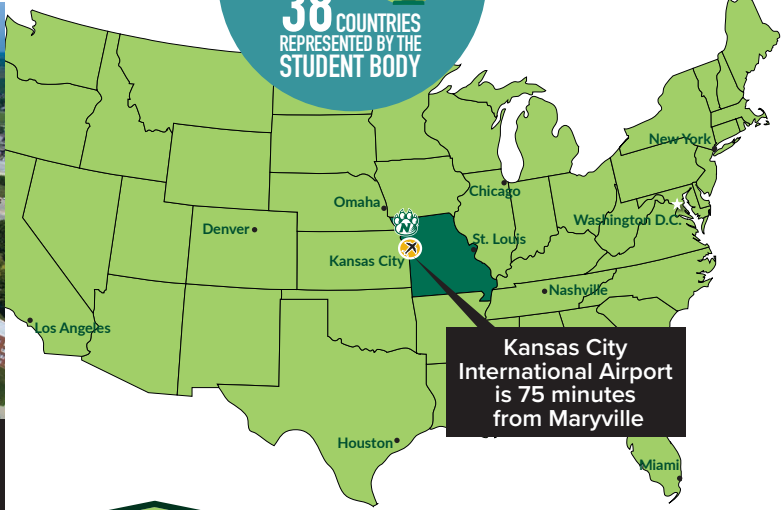

A Degree For English
