MBA Admission Requirements with GMAT/GRE Waiver

To apply to the MBA program you must submit an official bachelor's degree* transcript with a cumulative GPA of 2.50 on a 4.00 scale from an accredited university plus one of the following:

- A resume including three years of continuous, full-time professional work experience
- 3.50 overall undergraduate GPA
- Graduate degree from an accredited university with a minimum 3.00 cumulative GPA
- If you do not meet the above requirements, you may apply if you have a bachelor's degree* with a cumulative GPA of 2.50 on a 4.00 scale from an accredited university plus one of the following:
 - A GMAT score of 440 or above
 - A GRE score of 285 or above
 - An admission index of 1,100 (undergraduate GPA x 200 + GMAT)
 - An admission index of 965 (undergraduate GPA x 200 + GRE)
- English language assessment (TOEFL 79, IELTS 6.5, PTE 53 Duolingo 110)

*Applicants to the MBA program who do not have a bachelor's degree in business are required to successfully complete the MBA Business Foundation course in your first term, which is designed specifically for students who are new to business curriculum.

Program Requirements

The MBA program consists of 10 courses and can be completed in four terms. The program is open to anyone with a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution. However, applicants with a non-business degree are required to take one extra course, MGMT 54201 Business Foundations, as the first course in the program.

On Campus Work Opportunities

Graduate assistantships are available on a limited basis to students who prove themselves in their first term at Northwest. Graduate assistantships provide 20 hours of work per week with a stipend and tuition waiver.

In addition, some student employment opportunities are available on campus where students may be hired to work up to 20 hours per week, and are paid on an hourly basis. These opportunities are more readily accessible to students who have been in attendance for at least one term.
