

Northwest Missouri State University Board of Regents Academic and Student Engagement Committee Open Meeting Minutes June 16, 2025 Approved on July 29, 2025

The Northwest Missouri State University Board of Regents Academic and Student Engagement Committee met in open session via Zoom on June 16, 2025, pursuant to public notice given on June 10, 2025.
