

Northwest Missouri State University Board of Regents People, Finance and Operations Committee Open Meeting Minutes June 16, 2025 Approved on July 29, 2025

The Northwest Missouri State University Board of Regents People, Finance and Operations Committee met in open session via Zoom on June 16, 2025, pursuant to public notice given on June 10, 2025.
