



**Northwest Missouri State University Board of Regents  
People, Finance and Operations Committee Open Meeting Minutes  
March 10, 2026  
Approved on April 28, 2026**

The Northwest Missouri State University Board of Regents People, Finance and Operations Committee met in open session via Zoom on March 10, 2026, pursuant to public notice given on March 5, 2026.
