

Hello and welcome!

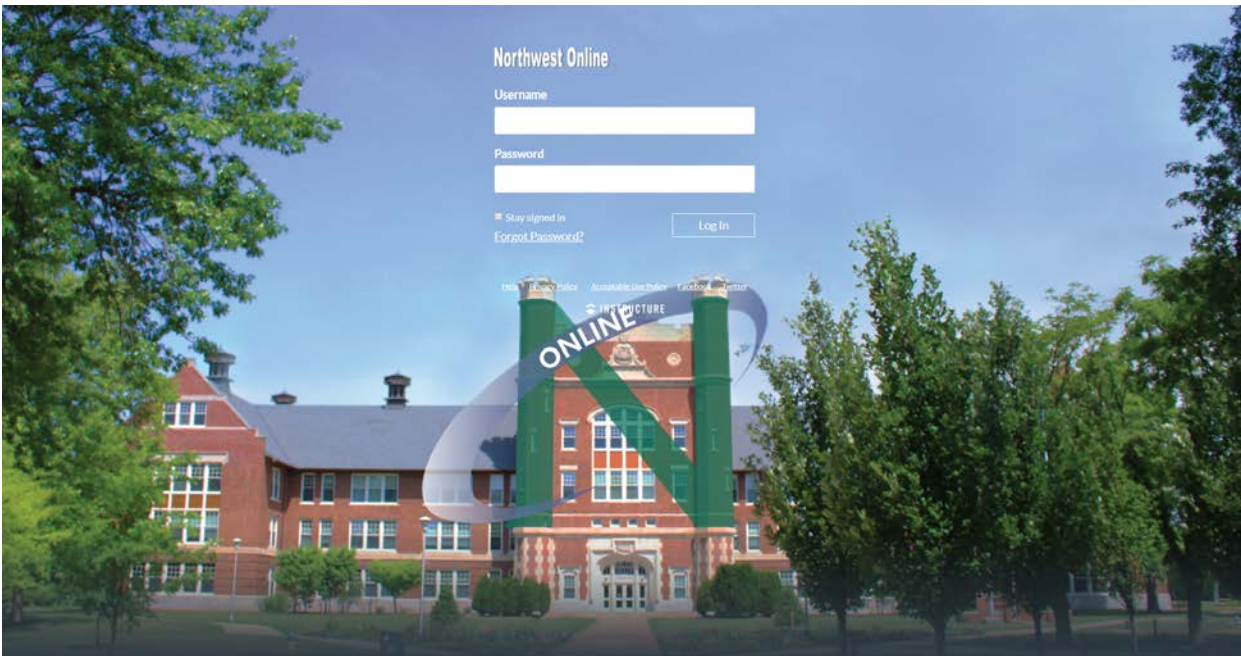

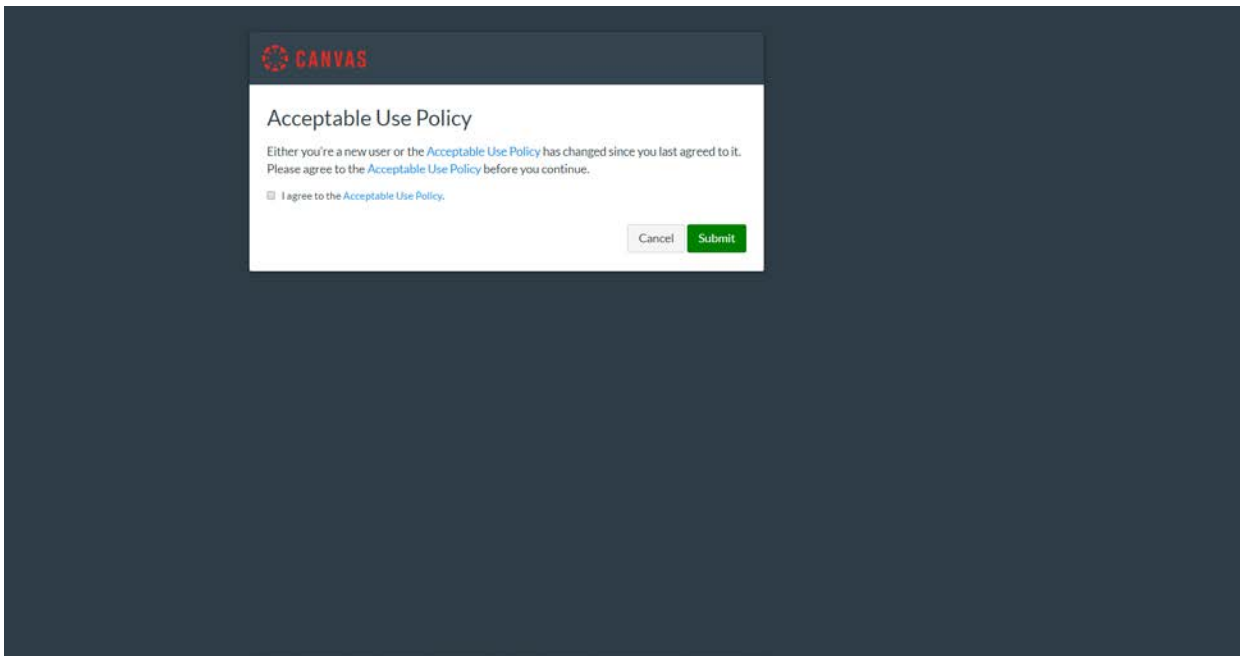

Once you have your Canvas username and password, please log in to our Learning Management System, Northwest Online (Canvas). Here are the steps to logging in:

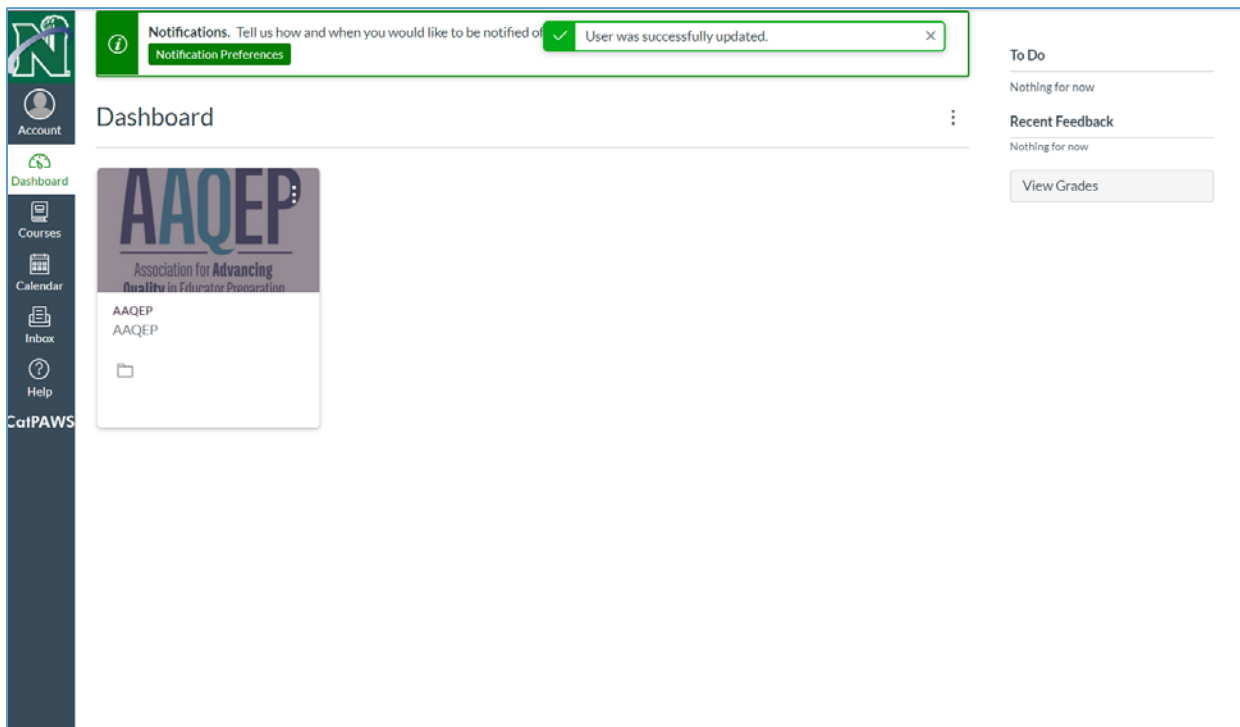
