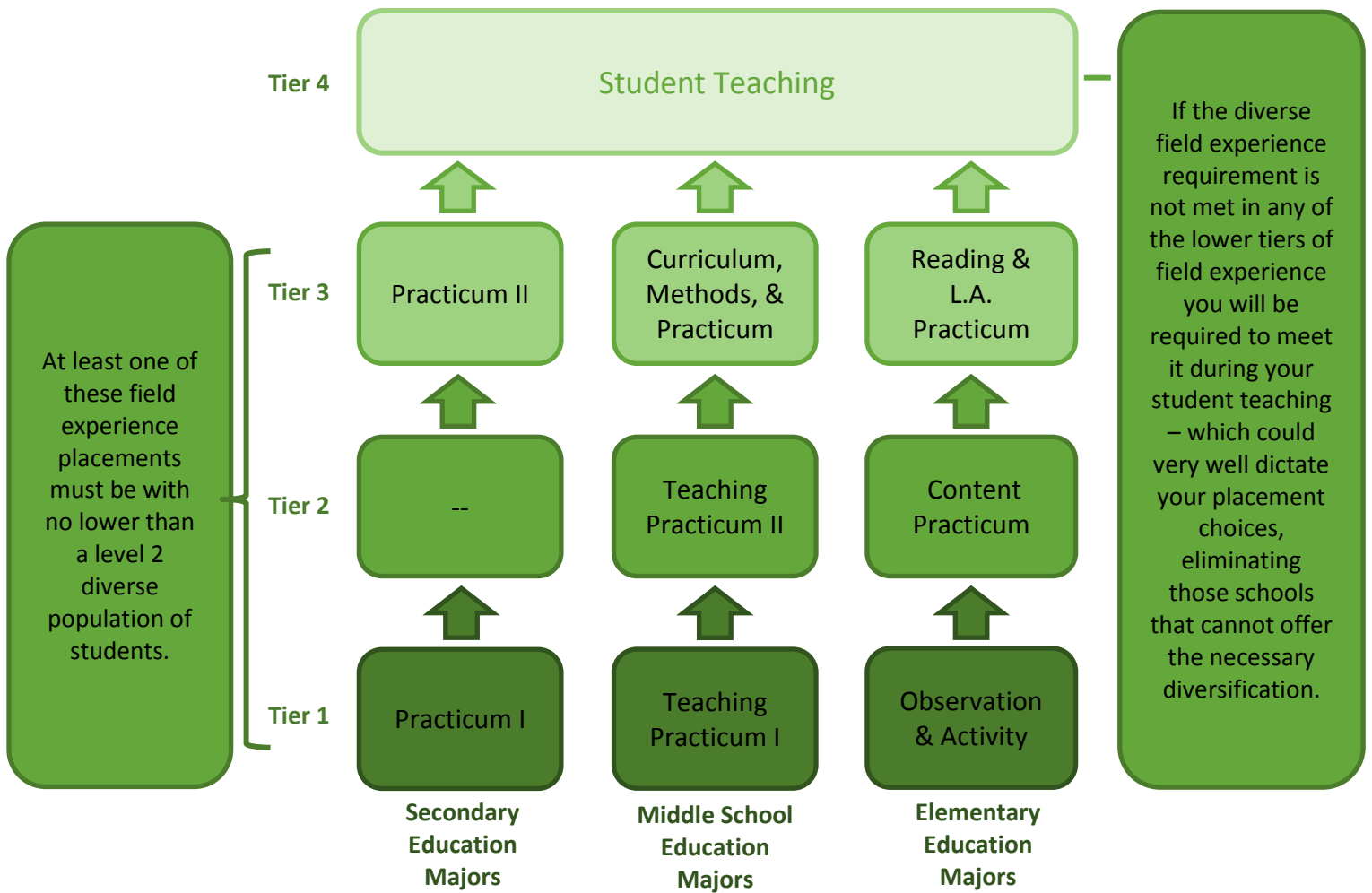


# Diversified Educational Field Experience Requirements for Undergraduate Students



3 Levels of Diversity

Level 1

Below average ELL/ race/ ethnicity/ low SES population.

Level 2

Average ELL/ race/ ethnicity/ low SES population.

Level 3

Above average ELL/ race/ ethnicity/ low SES population.

## Diversity Hours Required for Graduation

Degrees seeking undergraduate students seeking teacher certification are required to complete a 30 hour diversity experience.

As an undergraduate a student of the College of Education you will complete at least 15 of these hours in the Introduction to Special Education course you are a required to take; the remaining 15 hours are left up to you to complete on your own (limit 5 hours per category/5 hours per event).

These diversity hours are to be completed separately from the field experience diversity requirements listed above.

To complete these hours you must work with populations which may include the diversity qualifiers/categories of: ethnicity, race, socioeconomic status, gender, exceptionalities, language, religion, sexual orientation, geographical area, or age.
