

Tk20 Assessments by Student Teachers

The Assessment Coordinator sent the following survey questions to candidates upon completion of their student teaching experience during the 2012-2013 academic year. The following average results were gathered to each item according to these criteria:

Strongly Agree=4
 Agree=3
 Neutral=2
 Disagree=1
 Strongly Disagree=0

The following results indicate how easy and effective the student teachers believed Tk20 was during their experience. The initial results are quite low, although the overall average scores in the Spring 2013 trimester for both ease and effectiveness ranked between “Neutral” and “Agree”.
