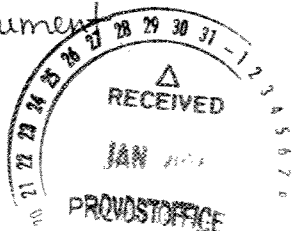

In responding to the comment card 8870, it is difficult to determine how to provide feedback to this faculty member regarding this card. There is not mention of a class, what elements of the class that need to be addressed and what the time period of the class or instruction might have been.

I sent the comment card to [redacted] to determine if she had more insight into this card. She in turn sent me all comments and ratings from her fall classes that were assessed through the student opinionnaire process. A review of those documents does not indicate the need for remediating practices or knowledge shared. In fact after reading the student comments from the fall class evaluations, the students were quite positive and indicated this was a class where they learned much and felt better prepared to student teach as a result of having the class.
