Transfer Scholarships

Transfer students with a minimum of 24 transferable credits may be eligible for scholarships if their transferable grade-point average (GPA) is the following:

3.00–3.29 transferable GPA: \$1,000 per year

3.30–3.49 transferable GPA: \$1,500 per year

3.50–4.00 transferable GPA: \$2,500 per year

Transfer students with fewer than 24 transferable credits will be eligible for freshman scholarships based on the criteria above.
