Northwest International Achievement Scholarship

NIAS is equal to approximately \$6,950 USD

Transfer students with a minimum of 24 transferable credits will receive the NIAS if their transferable grade-point average is 3.00 or higher.

Transfer Merit Awards

Transfer students with a minimum of 24 transferable credits may be eligible for the Transfer Merit Award and the Northwest International Achievement Scholarship if their transferable grade-point average (GPA) is the following:

**3.00–3.29 transferable
GPA: \$1,000 per year**

**3.30-3.49 transferable
GPA: \$1,500 per year**

**3.50-4.00 transferable
GPA: \$2,500 per year**
