

## OVERVIEW:

This agreement is intended to provide students who have earned an **Associate in Arts** at North Central Missouri College (NCMC) the opportunity to complete a **Bachelor of Science in Wildlife Ecology and Conservation** at Northwest Missouri State University (Northwest) during the 2023-2024 Academic Catalog. Meeting with an academic advisor is important to ensure students are meeting general education and major requirements.

## CONDITIONS OF TRANSFER:

### Section I: Admissions and Matriculation

- Under the provisions of the Memorandum of Agreement, students who meet published admissions standards will be eligible to matriculate at Northwest ([nwmissouri.edu/admissions/transfer/criteria.htm](http://nwmissouri.edu/admissions/transfer/criteria.htm)). Additionally, students who meet published scholarship guidelines will be awarded accordingly at Northwest ([nwmissouri.edu/finaid/aid/scholarships/transfer.htm](http://nwmissouri.edu/finaid/aid/scholarships/transfer.htm)).
