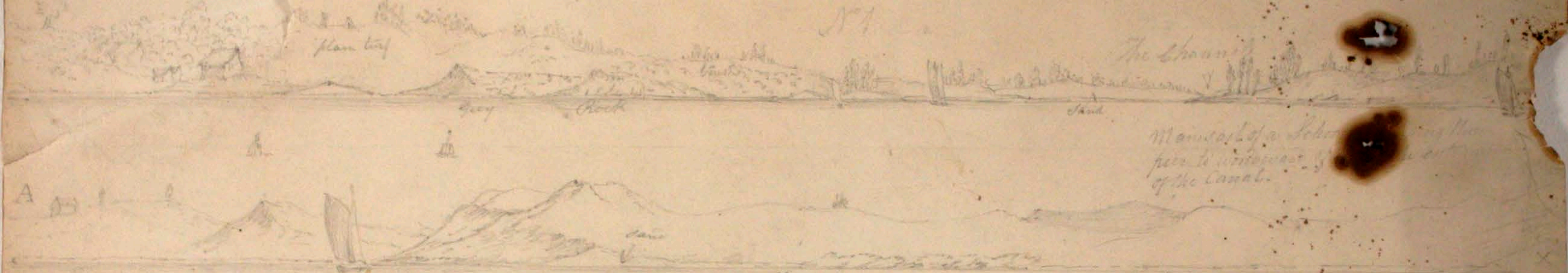

of the Canal.

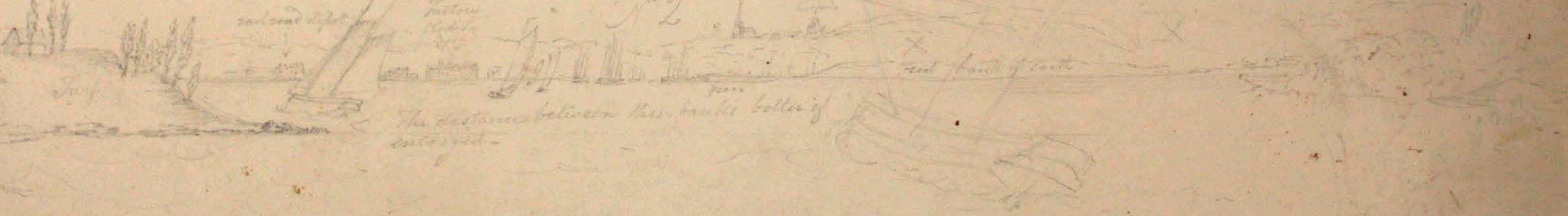
Subject. A ship going out with a fair wind

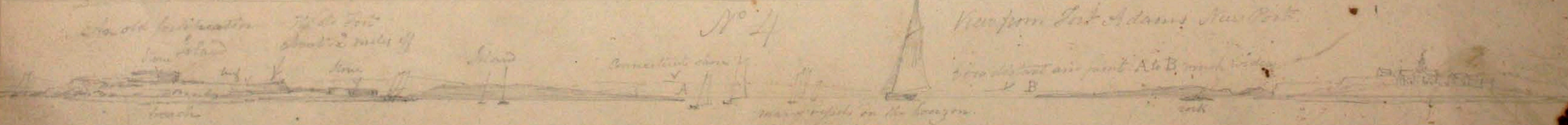
Blowing strong with a grey cloudy sky, the City distant, seen at a distance, the bulk of brush quite dark, the hill & covered with
