

## **Education Scholarship Descriptions** **To Be Awarded Fall 2012 and Spring 2013**

All scholarships are payable at the rate of 50% per fall and spring semester. Recipients must be enrolled as full time students. For junior and senior level scholarships, preference will be given to those students who have been admitted to Teacher Education. Funds may be used for tuition, fees, room and board, and other college expenses. Applications are available on the Curriculum and Instruction eCompanion site. Hardcopies of the forms must be turned in the box designated for scholarships in the Office of Curriculum and Instruction, Brown Hall 230 **by 5:00 p.m. Friday, January 13, 2011!**

**Scholarship amounts are not listed for the 2012-2013 academic year. You will be notified by the Scholarship Committee if you receive a scholarship. Some scholarships described below may not be awarded due to fund availability.**

**MARY EULALAH ADWELL SCHOLARSHIP:** (1 awarded yearly)

Recipients shall be enrolled in Elementary and Early Childhood, graduated from a Missouri high school in Gentry or Nodaway Counties, 2.5 GPA, accumulated 60 hours and classified as a junior, senior, or graduate student.

**KENT BARBER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** (1 awarded yearly)

Recipients shall be education majors, preferably with an interest in classroom teaching, shall have demonstrated high academic performance, and show financial need.

**DELTA KAPPA GAMMA III ALPHA OMICRON SCHOLARSHIP:** (1-2 awarded yearly)

Is awarded to a junior or senior woman in teacher education with a GPA of 3.00. The recipient shall be from one of the following communities: Albany, Barnard, Grant City, Maryville, Ravenwood, Stanberry, or Tarkio, Missouri, or Taylor County, Iowa.

**HERBERT R. DIETERICH SCHOLARSHIP:** (1-2 awarded yearly)

Will be awarded annually to a junior or senior education major who has expressed an intention of becoming a classroom instructor and has maintained a 3.00 GPA based on a 4.00 point system. At least one shall be awarded to a secondary education major.

**MARTHA POLSLEY GAMBLE SCHOLARSHIP:** (1 awarded yearly)

The recipient should be enrolled in the Elementary and Early Childhood Education program, accumulated between 60 and 90 credit hours, have graduated from a high school in Iowa, and has the highest G.P.A. of all candidates. Scholarship will not be renewable by same recipient. **No scholarship application required.**

**PAUL L GATES SCHOLARSHIP:** (1 awarded yearly)

Recipient of scholarship declared an Education Degree, GPA of 2.5, show financial need, and be a member of men's or women's varsity track team.

**MATTIE JO (PAYNE) GROOM SCHOLARSHIP:** (1 awarded yearly)

Recipients must be elementary education majors of good moral character who show promise of excellence in elementary education.

**JOHNSON-BUSH SCHOLARSHIP:** (1 awarded yearly)

Recipient must be a full time junior or senior student who demonstrates leadership, has a 2.85 GPA, and is majoring in Elementary Education, Middle School Education or Secondary Education.

**BOBBY & SHIRLEY KELLEY EXCELLENCE IN EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP:** (1 awarded yearly)

Must be admitted or demonstrate eligibility for admission to Teacher Education, have a 3.00 grade point or better overall, in major, and in education courses, and submit the following documents: a formal letter of application, a written statement entitled "What can I give to education that no one else can?", and 2 formal letters of recommendation. One letter from a Teacher Education staff member and one letter from outside Teacher Education. **PLEASE USE RECOMMENDATION FORM PROVIDED.**

**LGS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS:** (4 - 8 awarded yearly). Admission to Northwest or 3.00 GPA in previous college coursework. High scholarship. Based on financial need. Letter of recommendation from at least one teacher who can speak of student's probability for success and know of student's desire to become a teacher. **PLEASE USE RECOMMENDATION FORM PROVIDED.**

**MCINTOSH HALL SCHOLARSHIP:** (1 awarded yearly)  
Recipient of this award shall be an elementary education major, from any class level, and be a full-time student in the fall and spring trimester.

**CHLOE E. MILLIKAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP AWARD:** (2 awarded yearly)  
Two elementary education majors will be selected annually. Applicants must have completed two semesters at Northwest with at least 56 semester hours of academic credit and a grade point average of at least 3.00.

**RICHARD M. "DICK" NEW SCHOLARSHIP:** (1 awarded yearly)  
Recipients must be a junior or senior with a major in middle school education, a 2.75 GPA, be involved in professional activities, and demonstrate financial need.

**SHAWNA SEVERSON ZECH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** (1 awarded yearly)  
Recipient of this award shall be pursuing studies in elementary education or special education from any class level and shall maintain enrollment in at least 12 hours for the fall and spring trimesters. Applicant must Submit a one-page essay regarding a challenge or barrier they have overcome to pursue and succeed in their education.

**ELDON STEIGER SCHOLARSHIP:** (1 awarded yearly)  
A junior or senior student majoring in education with a 2.75 GPA. Applicant must show promise as a teacher and demonstrate financial need.

**TEACHER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIPS:** (2 awarded yearly)  
Memorials for Mary Jane Wilkinson, Roberta Westfall and Dorothy Silcott are included in this fund. Scholarships are awarded annually to junior, senior or graduate students in Education. Applicants shall have a 2.75 GPA and favorable recommendation of at least one faculty member. Letters from teachers and administrators are valuable. Students must submit a typed letter explaining their financial need, activities and interests in the field of education. One scholarship will be awarded to a qualified minority applicant.

**KENNETH T. AND ICEL THOMPSON SCHOLARSHIPS:** (1 awarded yearly)  
Recipients shall have a 3.00 GPA, have a declared major in special education, and show financial need.

**DONALD N. VALK SCHOLARSHIPS:** (3 awarded yearly)  
Recipients must be majoring in special education or a related field, have a GPA of 2.50, and show financial need.

**PAULINE F. WALKER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** (2 awarded yearly)  
Have attained sophomore status, elementary education major, 3.0 G.P.A., demonstrated financial need, including contributing directly to cost of education through employment.

**WIRTH FAMILY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** (1 awarded yearly)  
Scholarship is awarded annually to a person of good moral character, with excellent academic standing, have junior standing, and show promise for excellence in the area of education with preference for elementary education or guidance and counseling. The scholarship shall be given for use during the senior year.

**THE MARTHA FAYE (FOUTS) WOOLLUMS SCHOLARSHIP FOR INTERNATIONAL IMMERSION IN MEMORY OF REBA HUNTER FOUTS:**  
Recipient shall be an education major who will be doing an international study experience. The recipient must complete a minimum of six semester hours of pre-approved coursework. Students must have minimum GPA of 2.75. **Application form is to be sent to the Dean of Education, Administration Building 264, NWMSU**

**MARTHA FAYE (FOUTS) WOOLLUMS SCHOOL IN EDUCATION IN MEMORY OF EVERETT C. FOUTS:** (1 awarded yearly)

Recipient of scholarship shall be given to students from Gentry, Worth, or Harrison counties who are majoring in elementary or high school education at Northwest Missouri State University. Student must have a minimum of 2.75. If student is not from named counties the geographic restrictions will be lifted.

**MARTHA FAYE (FOUTS) WOOLLUMS SCHOLARSHIP IN MUSIC AND/OR EDUCATION IN MEMORY OF ALEXANDER FRANKLIN FOUTS:** (1 awarded yearly)

Recipient of scholarship shall be given to students from Gentry, Worth or Harrison counties who are pursuing the study of stringed instruments at Northwest Missouri State University. Student must have a minimum of 2.75. If student is not from named counties the geographic restrictions will be lifted. If student does not have the required course of study it can then include any music or education student at NWMSU.

**EUDORA WYMORE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** (1 awarded yearly)

Recipients shall have a GPA of 2.75 and completed a volunteer project with people who have a disability. One scholarship is reserved for an education major and one is reserved for a psychology major.

**ARTHUR "DOC" YATES AND MAXINE GOODEN YATES SCHOLARSHIP:** (1 awarded yearly)

Education major with minimum sophomore status and 3.0 G.P.A. committed to becoming a teacher. Applicants must demonstrate active involvement in variety of activities contributing to personal growth and the betterment of Northwest.

**LORNA FROM SCHOLARSHIP:** (1 awarded yearly)

Recipient must be an undergraduate student majoring in elementary education.

**JOANN MARION SCHOLARSHIP:** (1 awarded for fall semester)

Scholarship will be awarded to a senior Elementary Education major who will student teach during the fall semester. While financial need will be the leading criteria, the recipient must also have a desire to teach first or second grade and have a GPA higher than 2.5.

**BERT AND EULA COOPER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** (1 awarded yearly)

Are awarded annually to education majors who graduated from high schools in Gentry, Nodaway, or Worth counties in Missouri. Recipients shall be of good moral character, with excellent academic standing, have completed at least the first semester of their freshman year, and show promise as a future teacher.

**AMY P. ELIFRITS SCHOLARSHIP:** (1 awarded yearly)

Must have at least sophomore status and a declared major of elementary or middle school education. A minimum GPA of 2.5 is required.

**STACI MCENANEY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** (1 awarded yearly)

Recipient shall be a Northwest junior or senior elementary education major with preference for an early childhood minor, shall have graduated from Maryville High School, shall have a minimum cumulative 2.5 GPA, and show financial need.

**WANDA WALKER-SMITH SCHOLARSHIP:** (1 awarded yearly)

Applicants must be juniors majoring in elementary or secondary education and have a GPA of 3.00. Applicants must also be members of Student MST Chapter and be admitted to the Teacher Education program.

**VANCE & ZELINE GEIGER SCHOLARSHIP:** (1 awarded yearly) Teacher Education major, with a minimum 3.0 GPA, and who demonstrates financial need

**DR. KENT KING MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP:** (1 awarded yearly) Awarded to an education major

**MARY MARGARET LEWIS:** Two awards shall be awarded in the amount of \$500 each. The recipients shall maintain enrollment to be considered as a full-time student by the University. At the Committee's discretion, December graduates may receive the award in its entirety during the Fall session. The recipients shall be classified

as a University sophomore, junior or senior with a minimum GPA of 3.0. The scholarship shall be awarded following the preferences listed below:

- 1) Graduates of Northeast Nodaway who have declared a major in Elementary Education
- 2) Graduates of northeast Nodaway who have declared a major in Secondary Education
- 3) Graduates of Stanberry high school who have declared a major in Elementary Education
- 4) Graduates of Stanberry high school who have declared major in Secondary Education

**MILDRED GALLOWAY FITZSIMMONS MEMORIAL:** The recipient shall be classified as a continuing student (sophomore, junior or senior by the University and shall be considered a full-time student by the University.

First preference shall be given to non-traditional students who have declared a major in Elementary Education. Second preference shall be given to students from St. Joseph, Missouri who has declared a major in Elementary Education. If there is not a qualified applicant meeting either of the preferences, selection may be opened to any continuing student majoring in Elementary Education.

**DR. GAYLORD MORRISON SCHOLARSHIP** (2 awarded yearly)

Recipients shall be an education major with a 3.00 GPA, and be actively involved in financing their education through employment. Financial need shall be a determining factor. Preference will be given to a graduate of North Harrison High School, Eagleville, MO in upper third of graduating class who have met all other requirements.

**JOSEPH AND ROSE RYAN SCHOLARSHIP:** (1 awarded yearly)

Recipient shall be a junior or senior admitted to Teacher Education with minimum 3.0 GPA. Recipient must major in Elementary Education with and emphasis in Foreign Language or a major in Middle School Education with a minor in Foreign Language

**BART AND EMMA MAXWELL UTTERBACK SCHOLARSHIP:** (1 awarded yearly)

Recipient must be a junior or senior elementary education major with a minimum 3.5 cumulative GPA. In addition the recipient must have graduated from a high school in the Missouri counties of Harrison, Grundy, Nodaway, Atchison, Gentry, Worth or Davies and show financial need.

**ROBERTA F. UTTERBACK SCHOLARSHIP:** (1 awarded yearly)

Recipient must be a senior elementary education major with a minimum 3.5 cumulative GPA, have graduated from a high school in the 19 county district of Northwest Missouri State University, and show financial need.

**THE BEVERLY J. AND EDWARD J. SHELTON SCHOLARSHIP:** (1 awarded yearly)

Recipient of this award shall have a major in Education, graduated from the Independence Missouri Public School District or Nodaway county high schools. Preference will be given to students majoring in Music or Business Education.

**AWALT G. STEFFEN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** (1 awarded yearly)

Recipient shall have declared a major in Elementary, Middle School or Special Education with preference to Missouri residents. Academic Achievement and financial need will be the leading criteria.

**ABBY COCKRILL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP** (1 award)

Recipient shall be a junior or senior elementary education major with preference given to a Greek student. Academic achievement, effort, desire and sheer demonstration of the desire to teach young people will be the leading criteria.
