Students under the 2000-2002 (or earlier) Catalog will have until September 1, 2003, to achieve and submit qualifying ACT/C-BASE scores for admission under the previous requirements.

Previous requirements:

- C-BASE scores of 265 on each sub-test if 20 ACT composite or lower
- C-BASE scores of 235 on each sub-test if 21 ACT composite or higher

Students who fail to achieve the previous requirements by September 1, 2003, must then meet the new increased requirements.

Increased requirements:

- C-BASE scores of 265 on each sub-test if 21 ACT composite
- C-BASE scores of 235 on each sub-test if 22 ACT composite or higher

***Any student affected by this action is strongly encouraged to meet with his/her advisor as early as possible to ensure a full understanding of all options and implications.**

Other requirements:

- ❑ **Effective January 2003**, all students must complete a **Criminal Background Check** during Observation and Activity (63-211) or Practicum I (65-262 Middle School or 65-260 Secondary)
- ❑ Students are strongly advised to complete Western Civilization II (26-103) for the Humanities requirement before attempting the C-BASE.
