Dispositions are operationally defined as tendencies or beliefs that are conveyed or made public through observable behaviors. One of the goals of this form is to help identify students whose dispositions do not match those required for education. With that in mind, please answer the following questions as honestly as possible. If the candidate demonstrated appropriate dispositions, please choose only item number one. If the candidate did not demonstrate appropriate dispositions, please identify the specific issue(s).

1. Did the candidate demonstrate appropriate dispositions?
