Missouri Standards for the Preparation of Educators (MoSPE): On November 27, 2012, the Missouri State Board of Education approved the Missouri Standards for the Preparation of Educators (MoSPE). This is a comprehensive approach to educator preparation that includes several significant changes for students and educator preparation programs. This memo focuses on the changes regarding the assessments used in the preparation of educators.

The Missouri Educator Gateway Assessments (MEGA) is a comprehensive approach to assess the preprofessional development of students working for educator certification in Missouri. These assessments provide a common, statewide foundation of content knowledge, professional practice, and "what it takes to be an effective educator." The number and cost of these assessments have increased. The state board fully understands those implications; however, the focus is upon the development of quality educators for schools in Missouri. The assessments are spaced at different transition points throughout the preparation program. An investment in MEGA is part of your commitment to becoming a Missouri educator.

- Test Format: Computer-based at a testing center
- Test Windows Available: August 4-16, 2014 (Last Test Window)

- Cost: \$425 Test Number 6011, Missouri Qualifying Score @ 163

### School Superintendents Assessment (SSA)

- Purpose: Exit assessment for superintendent certification in Missouri
- Test Format: Paper-based only! (The computer-based assessment is <u>NOT</u> approved for Missouri.)
- Test Windows Available: There are two test dates scheduled for 2013-2014
  - o Saturday, November 2, 2013
  - Saturday, March 8, 2014.
- Test Sites: There are multiple test sites for each test administration date.

# Missouri Educator Profile (MEP)

- New Assessment for Fall 2013
- Purpose: The Missouri Educator Profile (MEP) is designed to be diagnostic, developmental, and sequential to assess the characteristics of candidates pursuing certification as a teacher, counselor, librarian, principal, and/or superintendent.
- Developed in conjunction with Evaluation Systems group of Pearson
- Test Format: On-Line & Computer-Based
- Test Windows Available: First Administration September 3, 2013
- Registration is scheduled to begin on September 3, 2013
- Cost: \$22.00

# New Assessments Beginning in the Fall of 2014

#### **Content Area Assessments**

- Purpose: The content area assessments are exit assessments that must be completed for all areas of certification. The exit assessment must measure the content necessary for principals and superintendent certification. The exit assessments must be aligned with state and national standards for school and/or district leaders.

- Test Format: Computer-based at a testing center
- Test Windows Available : Beginning in September 2014

- Purpose: The Missouri School Leaders Performance Assessment (MoSLPA) will be designed to demonstrate performance in content, coursework, and field experiences during the candidates' internship(s). The tasks will focus on the standards and quality indicators for school leaders.

- Test Format: Computer-based & completed during internship experience
- Test Windows Available :

  - o Implementation Fall 2014
