These courses were approved in December as part of Proposal 117-62-01, M.S.Ed. in Reading, and needed to be submitted on individual proposals. The motion was unanimously approved.

Dr. Ingraham moved to bundle Agenda Items 18-19. The motion was seconded by Dr. Smith and unanimously approved. This approves the work that DCM has done to make catalog copy to align with the new Missouri Core 42 requirements and efforts to improve the transfer of courses between Missouri institutions. DCM is going to continue to study this. The motion was unanimously approved.

Dr. Ingraham moved, seconded by Dr. Benson, to approve Proposal 118-28-01, Deletion of Course, SCED 28-200 Special Offering. The motion was unanimously approved.

Dr. Ingraham moved, seconded by Dr. Smith, to approve Proposal 218-17-01, Change in Course, MATH 17-117 Precalculus. The change in credit hours is needed to ensure the course is approved by the Missouri Math Pathways committee and can be used in the Core 42. Dr. Benson assured the Council that her department is going to continue to study this. The motion was unanimously approved.

Director of Teacher Education Report

Dr. Wall will attend several meetings in conjunction with the 2018 AACTE annual meeting in Baltimore in late February/early March. A new national accreditation group, Association for Advancing Quality in Educator Preparation (AAQEP) has completed a framework and expectations. These will be revealed publicly for the first time in a meeting on February 28 in Baltimore prior to the AACTE annual meeting. This group is moving towards national approval for accreditation of educator preparation programs. The meeting will share the framework that has been developed by 45 educators from the United States, including Drs. McBride and Wall from Northwest.
