Dr. Rena Smith moved to approve the minutes of the September 7, 2017, meeting. The motion was seconded by Dr. Linda Smith and unanimously approved.

Dr. Kreizinger moved, seconded by Dr. Rena Smith, to approve the agenda. The motion was unanimously approved.

Dr. Malm moved, seconded by Dr. Gordon, to approve Proposal 217-25-11, Change in Minor, Physics Education. Dr. Rena Smith reported that his minor was revised to meet the certification requirements. The motion was unanimously approved.

Director of Teacher Education Report

Dr. Farnan commented that the PEU retreat on September 29 was very beneficial and communicated good information. Dr. McBride indicated that we received good feedback. He suggested that we have a follow-up meeting to the retreat to provide information. As a result of the retreat, the data will be distributed in smaller portions throughout the year. Dr. Malm reported that the admission requirements for the redesigned program are being developed. There will no longer be an alternative admission policy since there will probably not be a content GPA required upon admission, but there will be an alternative approval to proceed with student teaching when their content GPA is between 2.75-2.99.
